#### ORDER:-

Based on the norms fixed by the All India Council for Technical Education, in their Notifications second and third read above, the Government in the Government Order fourth read above, have issued orders revising, among other things, the qualifications prescribed for the post of Principal in the teaching posts in Polytechnic Colleges under the control of the Technical Education Department. Accordingly, in the letter fifth read above, the Commissioner of Technical Education has sent necessary draft amendment proposals for revising the qualifications relating to the said post in the Adhoc Rules issued in the Government Order first read above. The Government, after careful consideration, have decided to accept the proposals of the Commissioner of Technical Education and issue the following amendments to the Adhoc Rules governing the post of Principal in Polytechnic Colleges under the control of the Technical Education Department.

2. The following Notification will be published in the <u>Tamil Nadu</u> Government Gazette:-

#### NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Rules issued with the Education Department Notification S.R.O. No.A 173 of 1969, published at page 210 of Part V of the <u>Fort. St. George Gazette</u>, dated the 16th April, 1969.

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the  $25^{th}$  May, 2010.

## AMENDMENTS.

In the said Adhoc Rules, -

- (1) in rule 3,clause (ii) shall be omitted;
- (2) for rule 5, the following shall be substituted, namely:-
- "5. Qualifications.- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by any of the methods specified in rule 3, unless he possess the following qualifications, namely"-
  - "(i) (a) A Bachelor's and Master's degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering / Technology / Architecture with not less than sixty percent of marks or its equivalent either at Bachelor's or Master's degree; and
    - (b) Ph.D from the appropriate discipline of Engineering / Technology / Architecture; or must have published five International Journal papers in the relevant areas of specialization, each Journal having a cumulative impact index of not less than 2.0, with incumbent as the main author and all the five publications being in the authors' area of specialization.
  - (ii) Experience for a period of not less than ten years in the relevant field of research / industry / teaching, out of which, not less than three years shall be in a position not below the rank of Head of Department in a Polytechnic or in a equivalent grade in other Institution:

Provided that in the case of Architecture branch, professional practice of not less than ten years, as certified by the Council of Architecture, shall also be considered as a valid experience:

Provided further that in the case of persons belonging to a service, the period spent by them on acquiring higher qualifications in Engineering will be counted towards the experience in the particular category of posts held by them before proceeding for higher studies:

Provided also that for persons holding the post of Assistant Director of Technical Education (Examination) in the Directorate of Technical Education, the period of service rendered in that post shall be counted only once towards the required teaching experience in the category of Head of Department in the Government Polytechnics.

### Explanations:-

- (a) In the case of research experience, good academic record and technical books / research paper publications / Intellectual Property Rights / patents record shall be required.
- (b) In the case of experience in industry, the same shall be at the managerial level equivalent to that of Head of Department with active participation in designing, planning, executing, analyzing, quality control, innovation, training, technical books / research paper publications / Intellectual Property Rights/patents record.

Flair for Management and Leadership shall be considered as essential.

(c) If a Grade Point System is adopted, in Bachelor's or Master's degree, the Cumulative Grade Point Assessment shall be converted into equivalent marks as mentioned below:-

Grade Point	Equivalent Percentage
6.25	55%
6.75	60%
7.25	65%
7.75	70%
8.25	75%

- (3) for rule 10, the following shall be substituted, namely:-
  - 10. <u>Savings</u>.- "Nothing contained in these rules shall adversely affect the persons holding the post on the date of issue of these rules,".
