ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, Guidelines were issued for admission to Part Time B.E. / B.Tech. degree courses in the colleges affiliated to Anna University from the academic year 2015-16. Among others, the guideline under the heading (vi) Employment reads as follows:

- (a) Candidates who are working professional at the time of admission are alone eligible.
- (b) Candidates should have a minimum of two years full time work experience in a registered firm/ Company / Industry / Educational and / Government, Autonomous organizations in the relevant field in which admission is sought at the time of admission.

2. In the letter second read above, the Director of Technical Education has stated that Coimbatore Institute of Technology, Coimbatore is the Institution conducting admission for Part-Time B.E./B.Tech. courses every year. In AICTE Approval process Handbook 2020-21, it is stated that 'candidates applying for admission to part time B.E./B.Tech courses should be working professional (or) professionals with atleast two years of experience'. Hence the Principal, Coimbatore Institute of Technology, Coimbatore has suggested that 'the period of training /Apprenticeship undergone after completion of the relevant diploma course may also be considered for the period of experience' in order to improve the admission strength of Part-Time B.E./B.Tech. courses. The Director of Technical Education has requested the Government to issue a necessary amendment order to G.O.(Ms).No.63 Higher Education(J1) Department, dated 07.04.2015 with the following revision in order to improve admission strength of Part-Time B.E./ B.Tech. courses:

“Candidates applying for admission to Part-Time B.E. / B.Tech. courses should be working professional (or) Professionals with atleast two years of experience”.
