The Special officer cum Dean, Government Medical College, Dindigul has applied for establishment of a medical college at Dindigul. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Tamil Nadu has decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a Government Medical College with 150 MBBS seats.


it is certified that:-

- (a) The applicant owns and manages a 300 bedded hospital which was established in 1935.
- (b) it is desirable to establish a medical college in the public interest;
- (c) Establishment of a medical college at Dindigul by Government of Tamil Nadu is feasible.
- (d) Adequate clinical material as per the National Medical Commission norms is available.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the medical college as per NMC norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the National Medical Commission, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the College with the permission of the National Medical Commission.

The Essentiality Certificate shall be valid for 3 years from the date of issue.
