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## ORDER:

Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project is being implemented with assistance from World Bank from January 2005. The Project has been provided with additional financing and extension for a period of 3 years from October 2010 to September 2013. As some of the project activities needed to be completed, no cost extension has been provided for the project period for 1 year upto 30.09.2014.

- 2. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project, has reported that the major activities of the project are as follows:
  - (i) Establishment and Strengthening of 24 hours Emergency Obstetric and New Born Care Centres functioning in 125 Government Hospitals to reduce maternal and infant mortality and morbidity
  - (ii) Activities to improve tribal health;
    - a. Mobile Outreach Health Services in Tribal Areas
    - b. Bed grant scheme for tribal patients in NGO run hospitals located in tribal areas
    - c. Sickle cell Anaemia interventions, Tribal Counselors scheme in hospitals located in tribal areas

- (iii) Prevention and Control of Non communicable Diseases namely,
  - a. Hypertension
  - b. Diabetes Mellitus
  - c. Cervical Cancer
  - d. Breast Cancer

through screening, treatment and follow up of positive cases and bring in life style modification in the community following intense IEC activities to create awareness in the community on risk factors leading to Non Communicable Diseases.

- (iv) Establishment of online Hospital Information System and Health Management Information System & Establishment of State Health Data Resource Centre
- (v) Establishment of Bio Medical Waste Management System in all Health Care Facilities
- (vi) Improving Quality of Clinical Care in all Health Care Facilities including Hospital Accreditation
- (vii) Establishment of Poison Treatment Centres
- (viii) Training on Rational use of Medicines
- (ix) Hospital Management Training for Administrative Medical Officers
- (x) Public Private Partnership activities
- (xi) Outsourcing of Certain Hospital Services
- (xii) Rationalization of Secondary Care Hospitals
- (xiii) Provision of additional buildings to hospitals
- (xiv) Rationalization of Equipment and Establishment of Equipment Maintenance System for Hospital Equipment
- (xv) Operating 108 Emergency Ambulance Services
- (xvi) Operating Free Mortuary Van Services
- (xvii) Operating State Funded Honble Chief Ministers Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme
- 3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project, has reported in his letter dated:09.08.2014 that the above activities are the initiatives of Government of Tamil Nadu and are models for other States to follow. The Project Director has proposed to properly document all the above activities. For the above purpose, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project had placed a proposal before the State Empowered Committee in the meeting held on 01.08.2014 for sanction of Rs. 5.00 lakh to hire a consultant for process documentation of the project activities. The State Empowered Committee had approved the proposal. The Project Director has requested the Government to issue orders in the matter.

- 4. This activity has been approved by the World Bank and comes under Component III and Sub-component D. The expenditure is eligible for reimbursement from the World Bank.
- 5. The Government after careful consideration accord sanction for incurring an expenditure of Rs. 5.00 lakh (Rupees five lakh only) towards hiring a consultant for process documentation of all the activities of the Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project.
- 6. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project is permitted to hire the Consultant by following the World Bank procurement procedures.
- 7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:
