ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have accorded administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.7,70,00,000/- for the construction of Nursing School and Hostel building at District Headquarters Hospital, Ramanathapuram.

2. The Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings) and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department, Chennai has sent the revised administrative sanction proposal for construction of Nursing School and Hostel Building at District Headquarters Hospital, Ramanathapuram for a sum of Rs.8,17,39,579/- and the details towards tender excess and other charges are as follows:-

The Director of Medical Education has requested the Government to accord revised administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.8,17,39,579/- for the construction of Nursing School and Hostel building at District Headquarters Hospital, Ramanathapuram as against the original sanction of Rs.7,70,00,000/-. She has countersigned and forwarded the revised estimate prepared by Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Madurai.
- 4. The proposal has been cleared by Technical Advisory Committee constituted in G.O (Ms) No. 146, Public Works Department, dated: 12.08.2011, to scrutinize the revised administrative sanction proposal in respect of all technical and financial aspects involved in the work and the Tender Award Committee in its 219th meeting on 01.06.2015, has approved the above said revised administrative sanction proposal for a sum of Rs.8,17,39,579/- against the original sanction of Rs.7,70,00,000/- with an instruction that, there should not be any further revised administrative sanction and subject to accuracy, correctness and genuineness of all informative data furnished by the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department.
- 5. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education and decided to accept the same. Accordingly, revised administrative sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.8,17,39,579/- (Rupees Eight crore seventeen lakh thirty nine thousand five hundred and seventy nine only) towards the construction of Nursing School and Hostel building at District Headquarters Hospital, Ramanathapuram, as against the original sanction of Rs.7,70,00,000/- (Rupees Seven crore seventy lakh only) accorded in the Government Order first read above.
- 6. The revised expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"4210-Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health-01 Urban Health Services -110 – Hospitals and Dispensaries (Including Pharmacy) – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II State Plan – JA Buildings - 16 Major Works" (DPC 4210-01-110-JA -1602)

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimate 2016-2017/Revised Budget Estimate 2016-2017 and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2016-2017/Revised Budget Estimate 2016-2017 to Finance Department at the appropriate time without fail.
