ORDER:-

The Director of Medical Education has forwarded the rough cost estimate prepared by Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chennai Region for construction of Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship (CRRI) quarters for 150 students (Boys and Girls) and Resident Quarters for 142 Junior and Senior Residents (Boys and Girls) in Government Kilpauk Medical College and Hospital, Chennai for an amount of Rs.15.40 crore for the year 2015-2016, approved by the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai, duly countersigned. She has further stated that due to space constraint, the building has to be designed and constructed as Ground + 7 Floors at the site with the existing old and damaged building of Sabarmathi Hostel in Government Kilpauk Medical College and Hospital, Chennai.

- 2. The Director of Medical Education has requested the Government to accord administrative and financial senction for a sum of Rs.15.40 crore for the year 2015-2016, for construction of CRRI quarters for 150 students (Boys and Girls) and Resident Quarters for 142 students (Boys and Girls) in Government Kilpauk Medical College and Hospital, Chennai.
- 3. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.14,00,00,000/- (Rupees Fourteen crore only) in the Schedule

of Rates for the year 2015-2016 (which includes 5% escalation on the Schedule of Rate 2014-2015 for construction of quarters for 150 Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship (CRRI) students (Boys and Girls) and Resident Quarters for 142 Junior and Senior Residents (Boys and Girls) in Government Kilpauk Medical College and Hospital, Chennai and permission to demolish the existing dilapidated old Sabarmathi Hostel buildings in Government Kilpauk Medical College and Hospital, Chennai and remit the net salvage value, if any, into the Government account.

- 4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-
 - "4210 Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health 01 Urban Health Services 110 Hospitals and Dispensaries (including pharmacy) Schmes in the Twlfth Five Year Plan II State plan JA Buildings 16 Major Works (DPC 4210-01-110-JA-1602)".
- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates 2016-2017/ Revised Budget Estimates 2016-2017 and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form A appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Revised Budget Estimates 2016-2017/ Supplementary Estimates for the year 2016-2017 to Finance Department at the appropriate time without fail.
