ORDER:

In the G.O. read above, the Government have accorded sanction for conducting 10 batches of training on the principles of Modern Nursing and Ward Management to Nursing Superintendents Grade I & II.

- 2. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has proposed to train 300 additional Nursing Superintendents working under the control of the Director of Medical & Rural Health Services and Director of Medical Education on the principles of Modern Nursing and Ward Management.
- 3. For the above purpose, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project had placed a proposal before the State Empowered Committee in the meeting held on 01.08.2014 for sanction of Rs. 18.85 lakh towards conducting the training to the Nursing Superintendents in the principles of Modern Nursing and Ward Management. The State Empowered Committee had approved the proposal. The Project Director has requested the Government to issue orders in the matter.
- 4. This activity has been approved by the World Bank and comes under Component IV and Sub-component III. The expenditure is eligible for reimbursement from the World Bank.

- 5. The Government after careful consideration accord sanction for incurring an expenditure of Rs. 18.85 lakh (Rupees eighteen lakh and eighty five thousand only) towards conducting the training programme for the Nursing Superintendents in the principles of Modern Nursing and Ward Management as detailed in the annexure to this order.
- 6. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project is permitted to conduct the training in 10 batches @ 30 Nursing Superintendents Grade I and II per batch. The training period will be 6 days. The training will be given in the Institute of Public Health Training Centre, Poonamallee, Chennai-56. The training will be given to the Nursing Superintendents Grade I and II, working under the control of the Director of Medical & Rural Health Services and Director of Medical Education.
- 7. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project is permitted to reallocate the non-recurrent expenditure within and across the components without exceeding the total amount sanctioned.
- 8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:
