## ORDER:

The Director of Medical Education, in the letter read above, has sent proposal for providing Lift [Bed cum passenger Lift SS Body having speed 1 m / second including power main for 15 persons capacity (upto Ground+Four floors) arrangements to the Maternity block (CEMONC Centre) in the Government Villupuram Medical College and Hospital, Villupuram.

- 2. The Director of Medical Education has countersigned and forwarded the rough cost estimate prepared by the Superintendent Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai, based on the schedule of rates for the year 2014-2015 and has requested the Government to accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.21.50 lakh for providing Lift arrangements to the Maternity block (CEMONC Centre) in the Government Villupuram Medical College and Hospital, Villupuram.
- 3. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education and accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.21.50 lakh (Rupees Twenty One Lakh and Fifty Thousand only) for providing Lift arrangements to the Maternity block (CEMONC Centre) in the Government Villupuram Medical College and Hospital, Villupuram as detailed in para 1 above.
- 4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

"4210 – Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services – 110 – Hospitals and Dispensaries (Including Pharmacy) - Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II State Plan – JA Buildings - 16 Major Works." (DPC 4210-01-110-JA -1602.)

- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund. Orders regarding the sanction of advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued by the Finance (BG-I) Department separately. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is directed to send an application in the prescribed format along with a copy of this order to Finance (BG-I) Department for sanction of advance for the required quantum. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is also directed to send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of the Expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate for 2015-2016 to Finance (BG-I) Department at appropriate time.
- 6. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.17432/Health-II/2015, dated:09.04.2015 and ASL No.4 (Four).
