### ORDER :

In Government order first read above, sanction was accorded for an amount of Rs.45,00,000/- being the Central and State share of Grants-in-Aid to the State Health Society for Health System strengthening for the Tribal Sub Plan Component under National Rural Health Mission for the year 2017-18.

2. The Mission Director, State Health Society has stated that necessary Proposals have been submitted to Government for the release of Government of India share together with State share towards the Health System Strengthening under National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) provided in Record of Proceedings 2017-18 and funds provided under Tamil Nadu State Health Budget for the year 2017-18 for a sum of Rs.44,53,33,333/- as detailed below:-

The Mission Director, State Health Society has also stated that Government order first read above, sanction was accorded for a sum of Rs.45,00,000/- only being State and Central share of Grants in aid for Tribal Sub plan instead of the proposed amount of Rs. 44,53,33,333/- being State and Central share contribution of Grants-in-Aid for both Scheduled caste and Tribal sub plan components.

4. The Mission Director, State Health Society has also stated that sanction may be accorded for Rs.39.67 crore (Rs. 23.80 crore + Rs.15.87 crore), being the Government of India share of Rs.23.80 crore under the Head of Account 2211-00-
