ORDER:-

The Director of Medical Education in the letters read above, has sent the proposal for Construction of Lecture Hall (250 students) in Government Chengalpattu Medical College Hospital, Chengalpattu to rectify the deficiency pointed by Medical Council of India for recognition of 100 MBBS students.

2. The Director of Medical Education has countersigned and forwarded the rough cost estimate prepared by the Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings) and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chennai Region and has requested the Government to accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.175.00 lakh based on the plinth area rates for the year 2014-2015 and Rs.192.50 lakh for the year 2015-2016 by adding 10% escalation charges.

3. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education and accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.192.50 lakh (Rupees One crore ninety two lakh and fifty thousand only) in the schedule of rates for the year 2015-2016 for the construction of Lecture Hall (250 students) in Government Chengalpattu Medical College Hospital, Chengalpattu.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

“4210 – Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services – 110 – Hospitals and Dispensaries (Including Pharmacy) Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II State Plan – JA Buildings - 16 Major Works.”
(DPC 4210-01-110-JA -1602.)

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimate 2016-2017/Revised Budget Estimate 2016-2017 and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2016-2017/Revised Budget Estimate 2016-2017 to Finance Department at the appropriate time without fail.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.74/ADS(Dr.PU)/Health-II/2016, dated: 04.03.2016 and ASL No.2572 (Two thousand five hundred and seventy two).
