Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project - Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme - Deposit premium of Rs.40,00,000/- for District Kiosk Enrolment – Sanctioned - Orders -issued.

ORDER:

The United India Insurance Company Limited,, Chennai, in the letter 1st read above, have requested for a deposit premium of Rs.40,00,000/- towards quarter premium for enrolment in District Kiosk to fulfill the requirements of 64 VB of the Insurance Act. United India Insurance Company Limited, have also stated that the deposit amount of Rs.40,00,000/- will be adjusted and replenished as and when the District Kiosk enrolment is approved by Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project and a monthly statement of account will also be sent to Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project indicating the balance available in the deposit account.

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has stated that premium payment as defined in the tender agreement is as follows:

- i. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Society, will pay the insurance premium on behalf of the eligible persons to the successful bidder.
- ii. The premium would be paid every year in four quarterly instalments on or before the first day of the quarter every year, with the year being reckoned from the date of commencement of the scheme.

- iii. The first premium for the first year of the scheme would be paid on or before the date of commencement of the scheme. The amount of premium would be arrived as twenty-five percent of the premium payable based on the number of eligible persons provided to the successful bidder by the Tamil Nadu Health Systems Society, on or before the date of commencement of the scheme. For the subsequent quarters, insurance premium will be released based on the number of health insurance cards issued.
- iv. In case a member is enrolled in the middle of the year, only proportionate premium shall be paid.

He has further stated that premium payment is made every quarter commencing from 11.01.2012. 1st quarter of premium was made for 1.34 crores families i.e based on the data given to UIIC and for subsequent quarters premium payment is made based on the number of cards issued. As per State Empowered Committee orders balance premium for the earlier quarters has also been paid on the basis of actual number of cards distributed. Premium for District Kiosk enrolment (enrolled the middle of year) is paid on pro-rata basis which is in accordance with the tender agreement. The claims of United India Insurance Company Limited in this regard is settled as and when the claim is received from United India Insurance Company Limited. So far premium payment for the District Kiosk enrolment has been paid upto 30.11.2013 as claimed by United India Insurance Company Limited. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has requested Government order on the request of the United India Insurance Company Limited, for deposit premium of Rs.40,00,000/- for District Kiosk enrolment.

3. The Government after careful consideration has decided to accept the above proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project. Accordingly sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.40,00,000/- (Rupees Forty lakhs only) for payment to United India Insurance Company Limited, being deposit premium towards quarter premium for District enrolment. The above deposit amount shall be adjusted and replenished as and when the District Kiosk enrolment is approved and a monthly statement of account indicating the balance available in the deposit account be sent to the Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project.

4. The amount sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2210 Medical and Public Health 80 General 800. Other Expenditure Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan II State Plan. JJ. Chief Ministers Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme – 10 contribution 02. Insurance Premium.
