In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued enhancing the stipend to the students of D. Pharmacy course of Madurai Medical College, Madurai from Rs.20/- to Rs.30 per men sum.

2. In the Government orders second and third read above, orders have been issued enhancing the rate of stipend to the Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery students. Since there is a considerable raise in stipend being paid for the students undergoing DGNM courses, the Director of Medical Education has requested the Government to enhance the stipend to the D.Pharm students, from Rs.30/- to Rs.400/- and Rs.440/- for the 1st and 2nd year D.Pharm students respectively.

The Government after careful examination accept the recommendation of the Director of Medical Education and decided to enhance the Government rate of monthly stipend being paid to the D.Pharm student in Government Medical Colleges from the commencement of the academic year 2015-2016 as indicated below:-
