## ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister (Health and Family Welfare), has made the following announcement while moving Demand No.19 of Health and Family Welfare on the floor of the Legislative Assembly on 14.6.2018:

"Office building for the DDHS in five Health Unit Districts now functioning in rented building will be constructed in a span of two years at a cost of Rs.5.00 crores."

2. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has sent necessary proposal for construction of three (3) Deputy Director of Health Services offices for the year 2018-19 at Tuticorin, Ariyalur and Aranthangi and two (2) Deputy Director of Health Services offices for the year 2019-20 at Kovilpatty and Villupuram along with rough cost estimate prepared by Engineer–in-Chief (Buildings) & Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department, Chennai, based on the plinth Area rates for the year 2018-2019 and by adding 10% escalation cost for the year 2019-2020 and has requested to accord administrative and financial sanction for construction of five Deputy Director of Health Service office buildings for a sum of Rs.582.40 Lakhs as detailed below, as per the Public Works Department estimates:-

  - (i). The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is permitted to construct new Office Building for five (5) Deputy Director of Health Service office at Thoothukudi, Ariyalur, Aranthanki, Kovilpatti and Villupuram at a total cost of Rs.5,82,40,000/- (Rupees Five crore eighty two lakhs and forty thousand only) as detailed below:-

- (iii). The Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai is permitted to issue orders to the Executive Engineers of the concerned divisions for the drawal of funds.
- 4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited into the following head of account:

"4210 – Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 04 – Public Health – 051 – Construction – State's Expenditure – JC Construction of Office Buildings for Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine – 416 Major Works – 01 – Major Works - ."
