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ORDER :

The Director of Medical Education in his letter fourth read above has stated that in the G.O. (Ms.) No.197, Health and Family Welfare (J1) Department, dated 29.07.2016, the Government have accorded sanction of 808 posts of various categories on permanent basis (688 posts in time scale of pay and 120 posts on consolidated pay) including 87 posts in the cadre of Medical Officer to the Government Medical College and Employees' State Insurance (ESI) Hospital, Coimbatore under their control.

2. The Director of Medical Education has also stated that in the G.O.(Ms.) No.130, Health and Family Welfare (J1) Department, Dated 24.04.2017, the Government have further accorded sanction for creation of 28 posts on permanent basis viz. twenty posts in the cadre of Medical Officers to Government Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore, six posts in the cadre of Medical Officers, one post of Resident Medical Officer and one post of Assistant Resident Medical Officer to Employees' State Insurance (ESI) Hospital, Coimbatore.

3. The Director of Medical Education has further stated that the Dean, Government Medical College and Employees State Insurance (ESI) Hospital, Coimbatore has submitted the proposal for creation of six posts in the cadre of Medical Officer to the Government Medical College and Employees State Insurance (ESI) Hospital, Coimbatore and requested the Government to sanction six posts in the cadre of Medical Officer to the Government Medical College and Employees State Insurance (ESI) Hospital, Coimbatore as per the Medical Council of India norms for obtaining second year renewal from the Medical Council of India at an average cost of Rs.97,96,500/- per annum.

4. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail in the light of the actual requirement of Medical Council of India norms for obtaining 2nd year renewal from the Medical Council of India decided to sanction five posts in the cadre of Medical Officer. Accordingly, the Government do and hereby accord sanction for creation of five posts in the cadre of Medical Officer i.e. two posts of Professor, two posts of Tutor and one post of Junior Resident at an average cost of Rs.83,20,200/- (Rupees Eighty three lakh twenty thousand and two hundred only) per annum to the Government Medical College and Employees State Insurance (ESI) Hospital, Coimbatore as mentioned in annexure to this order.

5. The Government also direct that the posts shall be filled up as per actual requirements of Medical Council of India norms and the expenditure towards pay and allowances of posts sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“2210. Medical and Public Health – 05. Medical Education, Training and Research – 105. Allopathy – State’s Expenditure – CC. Government Medical College and ESIC Hospital, Coimbatore – 01. Salaries”. (DPC 2210 – 05 – 105 - CC - 0107)

6. The Government also direct that the expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of “New Instrument of Service” and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund, orders regarding which will be issued by Finance (BG-I) Department. The Director of Medical Education is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates for the year 2018-2019 and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department, directly an application in Form “A” appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Director of Medical Education is also directed to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate for the year 2018-2019 to Finance (BG-I / Health - II) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department, vide its C.No.13919/Health-II/2018, dated 17.04.2018 and U.O. No.20363/CMPC/2018, dated 18.04.2018 and ASL No.56 (Fifty six).
