ORDER:

The Director of Medical Education, Chennai in his letters read above has sent the proposal for upgradation of the Department of Orthopaedics, Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore as Institute of Orthopaedics and Traumatology and also to accord sanction to upgrade one post of Professor as Director of Orthopaedics and Traumatology at Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore.

2.The Director of Medical Education has furnished the detailed justifications for upgradation of the Department of Orthopaedics, Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore as Institute of Orthopaedics and Traumatology and also to upgrade one post of Professor as Director of Orthopaedics and Traumatology at Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore as follows:-

- (i) Coimbatore Medical College Hospital is a 100 year old Government Institution and the referral Centre for the Western part of Tamil Nadu. The Department of Orthopaedics has to be upgraded as Institute of Orthopaedics and Traumatology for benefits of patients from below poverty line to provide quality and State of Specialty Care to meet the ever rising needs of the poor people from six districts for the Western part of Tamil Nadu;
- (ii) The infrastructure and equipments are already available as per Medical Council of India norms to suit the demands for upgradation of the Department of Orthopaedics as Institute of Orthopaedics and Traumatology for utilization by other neighboring Medical Colleges in Western part of Tamil Nadu and the Institute could develop the sub specialities like adult reconstruction, paediatric orthopaedics, paraplegia, sports injury and spinal cord injury services;

- (iii) Regarding the teaching faculty, two posts of Professor are already sanctioned for the Department of Orthopaedics, drawing salary in the time scale of Pay Band IV. Hence, one post of Professor attached to the Coimbatore Medical College Hospital may be redesignated as Director, Institute of Orthopaedics and Traumatology without creation of new post, so that the department may be upgraded as Institute of Orthopaedics and Traumatology. If the Department of Orthopaedics would be upgraded as Institute of Orthopaedics and Traumatology, the Institute could get direct funds from the Government of India for the research activities and, therefore, the infrastructure and equipments could be updated from time to time;
- (iv) The Institute can make Memorandum of Understanding with other Universities all over the world in consultation with the State Government, so that the research activities would be upgraded as per global standards; and
- (v) The Institute would involve in new innovative treatment for our own patients by using the funds from the Government of India in consultation with the State Government, since the anthropometry of South Indian population differs from rest of India.

3. In view of the above, the Director of Medical Education has, requested the Government to issue suitable orders for upgradation of Department of Orthopaedics, Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore as Institute of Orthopaedics and Traumatology and to upgrade one post of Professor in the Department of Orthopaedics as Director of Orthopaedics and Traumatology at Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore.

4. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and decided to accept the same. The Government do and hereby direct that the Department of Orthopaedics, Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore be upgraded as Institute of Orthopaedics and Traumatology, Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore and one of the existing post of Professor in the Revised Level of Pay Minimum Pay Rs.1,23,100/- (level 28 – Rs.1,23,100 – 2,15,900) in the Department of Orthopaedics also be upgraded as Director of Orthopaedics and Traumatology in the Revised Level of pay Minimum Pay Rs.1,23,400/- (level 29 – Rs.1,23,400 – 2,16,300) at Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore with the additional financial expenditure of Rs.5,040/- per annum to the exchequer.

5. The Government have directed that the expenditure towards pay and allowances of the said post sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“2210. Medical and Public Health – 05. Medical Education, Training and Research – 105. Allopathy – State’s Expenditure – AH. Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore – 01. Salaries”.
