ORDER:-

The Director of Medical Education, in his letters read above, has sent the proposal for construction of additional Nursing Hostel Building to School of Nursing in Government Head Quarters Hospital at Virudhunagar.

2. The Director of Medical Education has stated that the Nursing School was started during the year 2005 with an annual intake of 50 students per year. During the year 5 additional seats were allotted for Tamil Nadu Adi Dravidar Housing and Development Corporation Limited category. As per G.O. (Ms.) No.419, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 19.12.2014, from 2015 onwards the annual intake (Redistribution) of seats was raised from 55 to 100 (95+5). He has also stated that the existing School of Nursing building academic block was partially constructed in 2008 and 2011 for 11,631 sq. feet as per G.O. (Ms.) No.138, Health and Family Welfare (J2) Department, dated 26.04.2017 and the construction of remaining portion of Academic block is under tender process.

3. The Director of Medical Education has further stated that totally 255 students are staying now in the School building itself which is very congested. The new Hostel Building construction is going on which has 68 rooms to accommodate only 204 students (68 rooms x 3 student =204). The student strength will be 300 from 2017 October, hence additional rooms for 96 students are needed. He has also stated that the School of Nursing, Virudhunagar is functioning with an annual intake of 100 students. As per Indian Nursing Council norms 41000 sq.ft. is mandatory for 300 students and at present only 36614.89 sq.ft is available and hence there is a shortage of 4385.11 sq.ft. to satisfy Indian Nursing Council norms.

4. The Director of Medical Education has, therefore, requested the Government to accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.3,37,70,000/- for the year 2017-2018 for the construction of additional Nursing Hostel Building to School of Nursing in Government Head Quarters Hospital at Virudhunagar. He has countersigned and forwarded the rough cost estimate prepared by Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Madurai region.

5. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Medical Education, accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.3,03,45,000/- (Rupees Three crore three lakh and forty five thousand only) for the construction of additional Nursing Hostel Building to School of Nursing in Government Head Quarters Hospital at Virudhunagar.

6. The amount sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:- (Demand No.39-02)

“4210 – Capital Out lay on Medical and Public Health – 01 – Urban Health Services – 110 - Hospital and Dispensaries (including Pharmacy) – State’s Expenditure – JA Building – 16 - Major Works.
(DPC – 4210-01-110-JA-1602)

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall constitute an item of “New Instrument of Service” and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG.I) Department directly in Form “A” appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2018-2019 to Finance (BG-I / Health – II) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department, vide its U.O. No.16843/Health-II/2018, dated 20.04.2018 and ASL No.55 (Fifty five).
