ORDER:

In the letters read above, the Director of Medical Education has stated that based on the request of the Dean, Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital, Tirunelveli, the Engineer in Chief (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai has furnished the rough cost estimate prepared for the work of "Provision of additional loads, service connection charges and CEIG approval in HT service No.42 of Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital at Tirunelveli" for an amount of Rs.11,00,000/- for the year 2019-2020.

2. The Director of Medical Education has further stated that the Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital premises has utilized HT supply for more than 20 years. At present in Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital HT supply has been utilized in 2 Nos.500KVA/11KV/ Transformer which is functioning now. The HT supply sanctioned demand load is 500KVA. Now due to increased electrical loads in this Hospital for the newly constructed CEMONC Centre, Nurses Hostel, RMCH, District Early Intervention Centre, Infertility Clinic and new Cath Lab machineries, Medical equipments, AC units etc., the total load is being utilized for 720KVA. The permitted demand is 500KVA loads and that every month excess demand penalty fees is paid. The sanctioned load is increased and now the Regional Cancer Centre Medical equipment, Linear accelerator for I & II, CT Scans, X-Ray and AC units are erected, now shortly functioning. The electrical load is also increased in the HT supply point.

3. The Director of Medical Education has therefore requested the Government to accord administrative and financial sanction for Rs.11,00,000/- for the Provision of additional loads, service connection charges and CEIG approval in HT service No.42 of Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital at Tirunelveli.

4. After detailed examination, the Government have decided to accept the proposal of the Director of Medical Education. Accordingly, the Government do and hereby accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.11,00,000/- (Rupees Eleven lakhs) for the provision of additional loads, service connection charges and CEIG approval in HT service No.42 of Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital at Tirunelveli for the year 2019-2020.

5. The amount sanctioned at para 4 above shall be met within the Budget Estimate provision of Rs.40 crore to the Directorate of Medical Education under the following head of account:-

"2059 - Public Works- 01- Office Buildings. 053 - Maintenance and Repairs - State's Expenditure BV - Buildings - Medical Education (Administered by Chief Engineer (Buildings) 318 - Maintenance.


