## **ORDER**

The Mission Director, State Health Society in his letter second read above has stated that it has been proposed to establish Computer Training Laboratories in Health and Family Welfare Training Centres in the state to impart training on computer basics and various online works with reference to Health and Family Welfare schemes to Medical Officers, Staff Nurses, Village Health Nurses and other staff, so as to enable them to furnish the scheme reports through web based Health Management Information System and email services. He has also stated that a proposal for establishment of computer training Laboratories in the following Regional Training centres and institutes was included in PIP 2013-2014:-

SI.No.	Name and Place of Institutions
1	Institute of Public Health, Poonamallee, Chennai-56.
2	Health and Family Welfare Training centre, Egmore, Chennai.
3	Health and Family Welfare Training centre, Madurai.
4	Health Management Development Institute, Villupuram.
5	Health Management Development Institute, Salem.
6	Regional Institute of Public Health, Thiruvarankulam.
7	Institute of Vector Control and Zoonosis (IVCZ), Hosur, Krishnagiri District.

The above proposal had been approved by the National Project Coordination Committee of Government of India with a provision of Rs.21.00 lakh for civil and electrical works required for the establishment of above said laboratories, along with funds for other infrastructure.

- 2) The Mission Director, State Health Society has stated further that as per directions issued in G.O. (Ms) No.116 Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 25.03.2011, the additional fund of Rs.21 lakh approved for Civil and Electrical works has been remitted to the receipt head of account of Government of Tamil Nadu vide Chalan No.8007 dated 13.08.2013 of State Bank of India, Treasury Branch, Thousand lights, Chennai.
- 3) The Mission Director, State Health Society has requested the Government to issue the orders as follows:
  - i. The Mission Director, State Health Society Tamil Nadu, Chennai may be permitted to establish Computer Training Laboratories in the above said Regional Training Institutes and Institute of Vector Control and Zoonosis (IVCZ), Hosur, Krishnagiri District, at a cost of Rs.3.00 lakh each.
  - ii. The funds of Rs.21 lakh already remitted to Government account may be sanctioned to Public Works Department for the execution of civil works.
  - iii. The Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department (PWD), Chennai-5 may be authorized to issue orders to the concerned Executive Engineer of PWD divisions (Medical Works) for drawal of funds under the head of account "4211-00 Capital out lay on Family Welfare 103 Maternity and Child Health Schemes shared between Central and State"
  - iv. The drawal of funds may be allowed in this regard, pending provision funds in RE/FMA 2013-14, as the funds had been already remitted to Government.
  - v. The Mission Director, State Health Society –Tamil Nadu Chennai may be permitted to change the works and cost of works, based on the requirement of the institutions not exceeding the total funds approved.
- 4) The Government after careful consideration has decided to accept the proposal of the Mission Director, State Health Society and they accordingly sanction an amount of Rs.21 lakh (Rupees Twenty one lakh only) to the Chief Engineer Buildings, Public Works Department, Chennai for the establishment of Computer Training Laboratories in Six Regional Training Institutes mentioned in para 1 above and Institute of Vector Control and Zoonosis (IVCZ), Hosur, Krishnagiri District at the rate of Rs.3.00 lakh per institute.

5) The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

"4211-00-Capital outlay on Family Welfare – 103 maternity and child health – schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan-III. Centrally Sponsored – SA – National Component – Reproductive and Child Health Project – 16 Major Works (DPC: 4211-00-103 SA – 1608)".

- 6) The Mission Director, State Health Society is permitted to change the works and cost of works, based on the requirement of the institutions, not exceeding the approved amount.
- 7) This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance department vide its U.O. No.180/ADS(DrPU)Health-II/2014, dated 10.06.2014.
