ORDER:

The Mission Director, National Health Mission has reported that a proposal with a total budgetary requirement of Rs. 2606.00 lakh for strengthening of infrastructure in Government Hospitals has been included in PIP 2013-14 which was approved by NPCC, Government of India with an initial provision of Rs.781.80 lakhs for the year 2013-14, at 30% of total requirement of Rs. 2606.00 lakh which had been approved in the 24th Executive Committee Meeting held on 08.10.2013 vide agenda no.19 and the amount remitted into Government receipt head and sanctioned to Public Works Department vide G.O 1st read above.

2. The Mission Director, State Health Society has further reported that in the Supplementary ROP 2014-15, the balance of fund of Rs.1824.20 lakhs had been approved at 70% of the total cost of Rs.2606.00 lakh and the amount had been remitted into Government of Tamil Nadu account under receipt head of account, vide Challan No.1061, dated: 02.02.2015 of State Bank of India Treasury Branch, Thousand light, Chennai, to be sanctioned to Public Works Department.

3. The Mission Director, State Health Society has requested:-
(i) to sanction a sum of Rs. 1824.20 lakh (Rupees Eighteen crore twenty four lakh and twenty thousand only) to Public Works Department approved in the year 2014-15 for Strengthening of infrastructure in Government Hospitals already remitted into the State Government Account in addition to the funds of Rs.781.80 lakhs sanctioned vide G.O.(Ms).No.281, dated: 16.09.2014, for execution of civil works as detailed in the annexure to this order.

(ii) to permit the Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department to issue orders to the Executive Engineers of the concerned divisions for carrying Civil works and drawal of funds under the Head of Account "4211 -00 outlay on Family Welfare".

(iii) The Mission Director, State Health Society has further requested that the drawal of funds may be allowed in BE 2015-16 as the funds have already been remitted into Government account.

4. The Government, after careful examination, has decided to accept the proposal of Mission Director, State Health Society and accordingly,

(i) Sanction a sum of Rs. 1824.20 lakhs (Rupees eighteen crore twenty four lakh and twenty thousand only) to Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chennai for execution of Civil works for strengthening of infrastructure in Government Hospitals as detailed in Annexure to this order by availing the funds already remitted into the State Government account, in addition to amount already sanctioned in G.O 1st read above

(ii) The Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department is permitted to issue orders to the Executive Engineers of concerned divisions for carryingout the Civil Works required for Strengthening of infrastructure of Govt. Hospitals

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following Head of account:-

" 4211- 00 -Capital Outlay on Family Welfare -103 Maternity and Child Health – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – III Centrally Sponsored – SA – National Component – Reproductive and Child Health Project – 16 Major works". (DPC 4211-00-103-SA-1608)
