ORDER:

In his letter read above, the Mission Director, National Health Mission has stated that a proposal to establish Medical Care facilities for mentally ill and homeless patients/individuals in the following 5 Districts Vellore, Tiruppur, Tiruvannamalai, Theni, and Villupuram at a cost of Rs. 370.00 lakh to cater to the needs of such patients who require immediate medical care and shelter in addition to provision of rehabilitation services was included in the Programme Implementation Plan (PIP) for the year 2017-2018. The above facility at present is available in Institute of Mental Health Chennai and at Erwadi in Ramanathapuram District.

2. The Mission Director, State Health Society has stated that as against the proposed amount of Rs.370 Lakh in the Programme Implementation Plan (PIP) 2017-18 for the above facilities, a sum of Rs. 340.16 Lakhs (Rupees Three crore forty lakh and sixteen thousand only) has been approved in the Record of Proceeding as indicated below:

3. The proposal for the establishment of Emergency Care and Recovery Centres in the five District Headquarters Hospital at Wallajah, Vellore District, Kalakurichi, Villupuram District, Periyakulam, Theni District, Thiruppur, Thiruppur District and Cheyyar, Thiruvannamalai District has been approved in the 33rd Executive Committee meeting.

4. The Mission Director, National Health Mission has further stated that based on the discussions it has been decided to establish above mentioned medical care facilities in 5 Districts as "Emergency Care and Recovery Centres" through a reputed Non Governmental Organisations for successful implementation of the same, hired through a State Non Governmental Organisations selection Committee.

The above was also approved by the Executive Sub Committee, vide Circulation note No.11/SHS/P9/2017.

5. The Government after careful consideration have decided to accept the proposal of the Mission Director, State Health Society and accordingly issue following orders:-

- i. The Mission Director, State Health Society is permitted to establish "Emergency Care and Recovery Centres" 50 bedded wards in the following five District Head Quarters Hospital under National Health Mission in compliance with legal provision under Section-24 of Mental Health Act
 - a) Government District Head Quarters Hospital, Wallajah, Vellore District.
 - b) Government District Head Quarters Hospital Kallakurichi, Villupuram District.
 - c) Government District Head Quarters Hospital Periyakulam, Theni District.
 - d) Government District Head Quarters Hospital Thiruppur, Thiruppur District
 - e) Government District Head Quarters Hospital Cheyyar, Thiruvannamalai District
- ii. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is permitted to implement above scheme by involving reputed Non Governmental Organizations.
- iii. The Mission Director is permitted to select a Non Government Organisation through the State Non Government Organisation Selection Committee for the successful implementation of the above programme.
- iv. The Mission Director is permitted to roll out the programme in the 5 Districts by the selected Non Government Organisation through the Joint Director of Health Services of the concerned Districts.
- v. The following 15 posts of Medical Officer and 25 posts of Staff Nurse shall be created to the 5 Emergency Care and Recovery Centres mentioned at para 5(i) above and Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is permitted to fill up the posts, since he is the cadre controlling authority. The 25 posts of Staff Nurse shall be filled as per the seniority list maintained by the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services.

- vi. The Mission Director is permitted to place 50 Staff Nurses on contract basis through Medical Recruitment Board at a cost of Rs.7700/- with an annual increment of Rs.500/-.
- vii. The Mission Director is permitted to remit the salary component of the Medical Officers and Staff Nurses in Time Scale of pay posts (para 5 (v) to Government Account as per the existing procedure in the following Head of Account:-
0210-Medical and Public Health-01 Urban Health Service 800- Other receipts BC-Receipts under National Rural Health Mission 21 Receipts from central Government-03 Health and Family Welfare (DPC 0210-01-800-BC-2133).
- viii. The Mission Director, State Health Society is permitted to release the funds towards the salary of the following Human Resources (excluding Medical Officers pay & Regular Staff Nurses pay) directly to the Joint Director Health Service of the concerned districts with an instruction to fill up the posts through outsourcing with the qualifications prescribed by National Health Mission.

ix. The Mission Director, State Health Society is permitted to release the funds towards Diet, Miscellaneous Expenses, and Medical Furniture, Medical Equipment and Linen items directly to the concerned districts Joint Director Health Service with an instruction to procure the same by following codal procedures in force.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5(v) shall be debited to the following Head of Account :-

2210-Medical and Public Health 01 Urban Health Services – Allopathy
110- Hospitals and Dispensaries –State's Expenditure - AA
District Head Quarters Hospitals -01-Salaries
(DPC 2210 01 110 AA 0106).

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para – 5(v) above shall constitute a item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the contingency fund. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is directed to apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly inform A appended to the Tamil Nadu contingency Fund Rules 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2018-19 to Finance (BG-I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
