ORDER:-

In the G.O first read above, sanction has been accorded to Deputy Directors for Health Services for incurring an expenditure of Rs.28,000/- (Rupees Twenty eight thousand only) at the rate of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One thousand only) per district per year for all the 28 districts towards the cost of light refreshments and other contingencies in connection with the conduct of District Level Inter Departmental Committee Meeting on vital statistics.

2. In the letter second read above, the Registrar General India, Government of India, has informed to conduct monthly meeting at District level and half yearly meetings at the State Level. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has therefore requested the Government for enhancement of the amount for conducting the monthly meetings in the Districts and the half yearly meetings at State Level and for providing TA/DA with refreshment charges / working lunch, training material and other contingencies.

3. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine. Accordingly, sanction is accorded for incurring an expenditure of Rs.3,92,000/- (Rupees three lakh and ninety two thousand only) for conducting District level monthly meeting and State Level Half yearly meeting on vital statistics.

4. The Government also permit the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine to draw the amount of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty thousand only) as advance to meet the expenditure towards conducting the half yearly State Level Inter Departmental Committee Meetings on vital statistics and the Deputy Director of Health Services are permitted to draw an amount of Rs.12,000/- (Rupees Twelve thousand only) as advance to meet the expenditure towards conducting the monthly District Level Inter Departmental Committee Meetings on vital statistics and arrange to submit necessary adjustment bills as soon as the programme for which the advance drawn over.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to:-

"2210-Medical and Public Health – 80 – General – 004 – Health Statistics and Evaluation – I – Non Plan – AI – Vital Statistics Registration 72 Training" (DPC 2210-80-004-AI-7201).

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.2,37,000/- will be provided in Final Modified Appropriation 2014-2015. Pending provision of funds in Final Modified Appropriation 2014-2015, the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is authorized to draw and incur the expenditure. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is requested to include the expenditure sanctioned above, while sending the proposal for Final Modified Appropriation 2014-2015 to Government in Finance (Health-I) Department without fail".

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No. 457/Health-1/2015, dated 19.01.2015 with Additional Sanction Ledger No.2181 (Two thousand one hundred and eighty one).
