ORDER:

The Mission Director, State Health Society has reported that the proposal for upgradation of the Special New Born Care Units in Institute of Child Health Egmore, Chennai has been included in Programme Implementation Plan (PIP) 2014-15 under National Health Mission with provision of Rs. 47.00 lakh and approved by the National Programme Co-ordination Committee (NPCC) of Government of India. He has further stated that the proposal for establishment of 5 Special New Born Care Units (SNCUs) in 5 Government Hospitals in the year 2014-15 has also been included in the Supplementary PIP 2014-15 with a provision of Rs.50.00 lakh for civil and electrical works and approved by the NPCC of Government of India. He has further stated that both the proposals were approved in the 27th Executive Committee Meeting held on 23.09.2014 vide agenda No.15 and in 28th Executive Committee Meeting held on 12.02.2015 vide agenda No.16 and the total amount of Rs.97 lakh released by the Government of India has been remitted into Government of Tamil Nadu account, under receipt head of account vide Challan No.1284, dated: 31.03.2015 of State Bank of India, Treasury Branch, Thousand Light, Chennai, as per the Governments guidelines.

2. The Mission Director, State Health Society has therefore, requested the Government .

- i. to sanction a sum of Rs. 97.00 lakh (Rupees Ninety seven lakh only) to Public Works Department which has already been received from Government of India and remitted into the State Government Account for execution of approved civil and electrical works required for upgradation of the Special New Born Care Units (SNCU) in the 6 Government Hospitals as detailed below:

- ii. to permit him to execute the various Civil and Electrical works for upgradation/establishment of Special New Born Care Units (SNCUs) in the Government Hospitals as detailed above at a total cost of Rs. 97.00 lakh through Public Works Department.
- iii. to permit the Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department to issue orders to the Executive Engineers of the concerned divisions for carrying out the above works

3. The Mission Director, State Health Society has further requested that the drawal of funds may be allowed in BE 2015-16 as the funds have already been remitted into Government account

4 . The Government, after careful examination, accept the proposal of Mission Director, State Health Society and accordingly issue orders as follows:

- i. sanction is accorded for incurring an expenditure of Rs.97.00 lakh (Rupees Ninety seven lakhs only) to Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings) towards the civil and electrical works required for upgradation of the Special New Born Care Units (SNCU) in the following 6 Government Hospitals as detailed below:

- i. permit him to execute the civil and Electrical works for upgradation/ establishment of Special New Born Care Units (SNCU) in the Governments Hospitals as detailed at para 4(i) above at a total cost of Rs. 97.00 lakh (Rupees Ninety seven lakh only) through Public Works Department
- ii. the Engineer in Chief (Buildings) Public Works Department is permitted to issue orders to the Executive Engineers of the concerned divisions for carrying out the Civil & Electrical Works in the 6 Government Hospitals detailed at para 4(i) above
