ORDER:

The Correspondent, Priyam Medical Foundation, Salem has applied for permission to start Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Course in the name of "Priyam Institute of Paramedical Sciences" with an annual intake of 20 students per batch / per year.

- 2. In the letter fourth read above, the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has stated that the Correspondent, Priyam Medical Foundation, Salem has applied for permission to start Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Training Course in the name of "Priyam Institute of Paramedical Sciences" with an annual intake of 20 students per batch / per year and the Institution has submitted the application duly filled in the prescribed format and the Joint Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine (Training) has inspected the above Institution on 13.2.2018 and the guidelines for the course have been followed and necessary supporting documents have also been furnished by the Institution.
- 3. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has also recommended and requested to accord permission to Priyam Medical Foundation, Salem to start Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Training Course in the name of "Priyam Institute of Paramedical Sciences" at 247, Bangalore By-Pass Road, Near

Kondalampatti Roundana, Salem with an annual intake of 20 students per batch / per year, subject to the following conditions:-

- The Institution should obtain approval from the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and Registrar, Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council, Chennai before starting the course.
- ii. The examination can be conducted for the trainees who are undergoing the Auxiliary Nurse Midwife course in the above said Private Nursing School by the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine being the Chairman of Board of Examination, subject to the following conditions:
 - a) The internship for these trainees should be conducted in an Upgraded Government Primary Health Centres / Community Health Centres for a period of at least three months.
 - b) The trainees should undergo field practice in the identified Government Primary Health Centres only after paying the prescribed fees.
 - c) The Private Nursing Schools should construct building in the Affiliated Community Health Centres for accommodating the trainees.
 - d) The Institution and candidates should pay the examination fees at the rate of Rs.1000/- per paper per semester and other fees prescribed by the Government from time to time.
- 4. The institution has submitted the following particulars as stipulated in the G.O 1st to 3rd read above:
 - i. The undertaking is given in Rs.60/- Judicial stamp papers instead of Rs.5/- Judicial Stamp paper, as per the stipulations in guidelines.
 - ii. An endowment fund for Rs.5/- lakh (Rupees Five lakh only) in the joint name of the Trust/Private Management and pledged in favour of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine (in his official capacity)
 - iii. Building Plan showing of class rooms, library, hostel and mess facilities duly approved by the Commissioner of Salem Corporation.
 - iv. The Experience and Qualification Certificates of Principal and Tutors as per Indian Nursing Council norms.
- 5. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the recommendation of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine and accordingly permit the Correspondent, Priyam Medical Foundation, Salem to start Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Course in the name of "Priyam Institute of Paramedical Sciences" at Salem with an annual intake of 20 students per batch from the Academic Year 2018-19, subject to fulfillment of the conditions prescribed in G.O. 1st to 3rd read above and to submit the Building Completion Certificate approved by the Director of Town and Country Planning to the Government, before admitting the students for the above said course.

6. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine shall ensure that the above Institution has submitted the Building Plan and Building Completion Certificate approved by the Director of Town and Country Planning before admitting the students in the course.
