Finally, the Mission Director has requested the Government to issue orders for the drawal of Rs.312,64,00,000/- (Rupees Three hundred twelve crore and sixty four lakh only - with 100% centrally funded no state Share) towards Emergency Response and Health System Preparedness and management and control of Covid-19 under National Rural

Health Mission during the Financial year 2020-21, since, the Government of India have transferred the Grants-in-Aid to State Government for draws of amount through Treasury. The Mission Director has also requested to authorize him to draw the above amount through Treasury made and credit into National Health Mission Account.
