ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above the Government have sanctioned Rs. 480.00 lakh towards procurement of 32 Mammography Units at the rate of Rs.15.00 lakh per Unit for supply to Government Medical College Hospitals and District Head Quarters Hospitals in districts where there is no Government Medical College Hospitals. However, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project was permitted to initially procure 18 Mammography Units in Phase I and the rest under Phase II of the Programme.

2. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has stated that based on the opinion of technical experts, it has been decided to procure Mammography Unit with Computed Radiography System instead of conventional Mammography Unit and also to supply 30 numbers of Mammography Units with Computed Radiography System, which includes, 22 Government Secondary Care Hospitals and 8 Medical College Hospitals and 13 Computed Radiography Systems only for 13 Mammography Units at 13 Medical College Hospitals. He has also stated that the market cost of a Mammography Unit is approximately Rs.45.00 lakh that the cost of a Computed Radiography System is approximately Rs.20.00 lakh for Unit and that the estimated cost of procurement of the Mammography Units with Computed Radiography System will be Rs.1610.00 lakh. Taking in to account the amount of Rs.480.00 lakh already sanctioned in the G.O read above, the Project Director has proposed to sanction an additional amount of Rs.1130.00 lakh.

3. Accordingly, in view of urgency, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project had circulated a proposal to the State Empowered Committee for sanction of an additional amount of Rs.1130.00 lakh towards supply of Mammography Unit with Computed Radiography System. The State Empowered Committee had approved the proposal. The Project Director has requested the Government to issue orders in the matter.

4. This activity has been approved by the World Bank and comes under Component II and Sub - Component B. The expenditure is eligible for reimbursement from the World Bank.

5. The Government, after careful consideration, accord sanction for incurring an additional expenditure of Rs.1130.00 lakh (Rupees Eleven Crore and Thirty Lakh only), over and above the expenditure of Rs.480.00 lakh already sanctioned in the G.O first read above, towards procurement of 30 numbers of Mammography Units with Computed Radiography System, which includes 22 Government Secondary Care Hospitals and 8 Medical College Hospitals and 13 Computed Radiography Systems only for 13 Mammography Units at 13 Medical College Hospitals.

6. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project is permitted to procure the Mammography Units through the Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation by following the World Bank procurement procedures.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

"2210 – Medical and Public Health – 06. Public Health- 101 – Prevention and Control of Diseases – Scheme in the Twelfth Five Year Plan –II. State Plan – PA Pilot Testing of Non-Communicable Diseases under Health Systems Project – 19. Machinery and Equipments – 01. Purchase (DPC: 2210 06 101 PA 1917)".

8. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project is permitted to transfer the amount of Rs.1130.00 lakh towards procurement of Mammography Units, to the Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited by Cheque and credit it to the Public Deposit account of Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited under the following head of account. "K Deposits and Advances (b) – Deposits not bearing interest – 8443.00 Civil Deposits – 800. Other Deposits of Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited (D.P. Code:8443 00 800 CE 000H (Receipts)".

9. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited is permitted to procure the Units by calling for tenders by following World Bank Procurement procedure. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation is requested to supply the Mammography Units to the concerned Government Hospitals as per the list to be given by the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project and to settle the account with the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project after completing the work.

10. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of legislature will be obtained in the course. Pending approval of legislature the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the contingency fund. Order for sanction of advance from the contingency fund will be issued by the Finance (BG-I) Department. The Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project shall apply for sanction of advance from contingency fund for the amount required immediately in the prescribed format along with a copy of the orders to Finance (BG-I) Department.

11. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project is permitted to increase / decrease the number of Units to be purchased and increase / decrease the number of Hospitals or change the Hospitals to be provided with these facilities based on need and requirement within the overall amount sanctioned.

12. This order issues with the concurrence of the State Empowered Committee constituted in G.O. (Ms) No.28, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated: 28.02.2005 and Finance Department, vide its U.O.No.10201/Health-II/2014, dated: 27.02.2014 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.62 (Sixty two).
