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### **ORDER:**

The Mission Director, National Health Mission has reported that a proposal with a total budgetary requirement of Rs.2250.00 lakh for executing civil works for strengthening the infrastructure of Government Hospitals has been included in PIP 2013-14 and approved by the National Programme Co-ordination Committee (NPCC) of Government of India with an initial provision of Rs.1125.00 lakh at 50% of total requirement for Civil works for the year 2013-14. The E.C approved the same in its 24<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 08.10.2013, the amount remitted into Government of Tamil Nadu account, under receipt head of account vide ChallanNo.8706, dated: 16.09.2014 of State Bank of India, Treasury Branch, Thousand Light, Chennai, as per the Governments guidelines and sanction to Public Works Department for execution of work in the G.O first read above.

2. The Mission Director, State Health Society has also reported that the proposal for release of the remaining 50% amount of Rs.1125.00 lakh, has been included in the Supplementary PIP 2014-15 approved for the year 2014-15 and the amount received from Government of India remitted into Government of Tamil Nadu account, under receipt head of account vide challan no.206, dated: 28.03.2015 of State Bank of India, Treasury Branch Thousand Light, Chennai.

3. The Mission Director, State Health Society, has therefore, requested the Government;-

- I. to sanction a sum of Rs. 1125.00 lakh (Rupees Eleven Crore and twenty five lakh only), approved and released by the Government of India, to Public Works Department for execution of civil works for strengthening the infrastructure of

Government Hospitals in the state as detailed in the annexure to this order for the year 2014-15 in addition to the fund of Rs.1125.00 lakh already sanctioned in the Government Order first read above, and

- II. to permit the Engineer in Chief (Buildings), Public Works Department to issue orders to the Executive Engineers of the concerned divisions for carrying out the civil works .

4. The Government, after careful examination, accept the proposal of Mission Director, State Health Society and accordingly,

- (i) sanction a sum of Rs. 1125.00 lakh (Rupees Eleven crore and twenty five lakh only) to Engineer in Chief (Buildings), Public Works Department for execution of civil works for strengthening the infrastructure of Government Hospitals, detailed in annexure to this orders in addition to funds already sanctioned in Government Order 1<sup>st</sup> read above, and
- (ii) the Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer ( Buildings) Public Works Department is permitted to issue orders to the Executive Engineers of the concerned divisions for carrying out the Civil Works.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following Head of account:-

“ 4211-00-Capital outlay on Family Welfare -103 Maternity and Child Health – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – III Centrally Sponsored – SA – National Component – Reproductive and Child Health Project – 16 Major works”. (DPC 4211-00-103-SA-1608)
