ORDER:

The Chairman, Pannai Charitable and Educational Trust, Dindigul District has requested to grant permission to apply to the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi to start two years D. Pharm course at Pannai College of Pharmacy, Dindigul with an annual intake of 60 students from the academic year 2018-2019.

2. The Director of Medical Education has constituted an inspection team to verify as to whether the proposed College of Pharmacy has fulfilled the conditions prescribed by the Government and the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi. The Director of Medical Education has submitted the proposal with the Inspection Report / Project Report along with his specific recommendation to the Government and requested to issue necessary orders.

3. The Government have examined the case in detail in the light of the Inspection Report and the recommendation of the Director of Medical Education and grant permission to the Chairman, Pannai Charitable and Educational Trust, Dindigul District based on the recommendation of the inspection team and the remarks of the Director of Medical Education to apply to the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi to start 2 years D.Pharm course at Pannai College of Pharmacy, Dindigul in S.No.298/1A4A, 298/3B, 297/3A1 and 298/1B, Mullipadi Village, Thamarapadi, Dindigul District with an annual intake of 60 seats from the academic year 2018-2019, subject to the following conditions:-

- a. Admission of students should be made as per the rules fixed by the Government from time to time;

- b. Tuition fees including special fees should be collected from the students at the same rates as prescribed by the Government from time to time. The Management should also give separate undertaking stating that NO CAPITATION FEE or any other fund in the name of building fund, etc. will be collected from the students seeking admission in the Private Self Financing Pharmacy Colleges;
 - c. The Trust should obtain recognition and affiliation from the Pharmacy Council of India and the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University respectively before admitting the students;
 - d. The Government have the right to utilize the Endowment fund created by the Trust in meeting the justifiable payment to students that may arise due to non compliance of rules and regulations of the Government by the Trust like winding up of course without valid reasons, etc;
 - e. The Institute so permitted to conduct the course will be allowed to shift / change the study centres only after completion of three years from the date of actual commencement of the course by the first batch of students, after getting orders of Government on re-inspection of the centres;
 - f. The Trust should obtain the building completion certificate from the competent authority for the proposed Pharmacy College and submit to the Government before admitting the students.
4. The Director of Medical Education is directed to take necessary further action accordingly.
