ORDER:

The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine in his letter read above has stated that the District Collector, Erode has proposed to fill up the vacancies of Village Health Nurse / Auxiliary Nurse Midwife in hilly areas, which are kept vacant for more than two years, by giving ANM training to the qualified people living in those areas and to give postings to them as Village Health Nurse / Auxiliary Nurse Midwife in the same area, thereby avoiding frequent transfer requests and thereby providing round the clock health care facilities to the people living in hilly areas. He has therefore requested the necessary permission and financial sanction of the Government.

2) The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has recommended that this proposal as it will improve the field level services and if this idea is implemented in future, the number of vacancies prevailing in hilly areas will considerably be reduced. He has therefore requested the Government to accord necessary permission for implementing training to the candidates selected from hilly areas and to issue posting orders with the following selection procedure:-

Method of selection and place of postings:

The willing local residents residing in hilly areas will be selected to undergo training as per the following norms:-

- i. 30 candidates per year can be selected for training.
 - a) 15 from open advertisement
 - b) 15 from integrated Child Development Scheme Workers in the identified Health Sub Centre area.
- ii. Communal roster will be followed.
- iii. Same qualification as prescribed by the Nursing Council (ie) should have passed Higher Secondary.
- iv. Selected candidates should be willing to work at least for 5 years in any of the identified Health Sub Centre of Hilly areas.

Venue for Training:

Marandahalli ANM School in Dharmapuri District.

District level selection committee:

- i. The concerned District Collector headed the committee comprising of Deputy Director of Health Services, District Social Welfare Officer, Project Officer, Integrated Child Development Scheme and District Maternal and Child Health Officers will select the candidates as per eligibility conditions prescribed therein.
- 3) The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine and accord
- i. permission to fill up the vacancies of Village Health Nurse / Auxiliary Nurse Midwife in hilly areas by giving ANM training to 30 qualified candidates, who are living in those areas for every year and to give postings to them as Village Health Nurse / Auxiliary Nurse Midwife in the same area as per selection and posting procedure mentioned in para 2 above.
 - ii. permission to fill up the 30 vacancies of the post of Village Health Nurse / Auxiliary Nurse Midwife in hilly areas in Erode District on pilot basis for this year as per selection and posting procedure mentioned in para 2 above.
