ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued permitting Government Medical College and ESI Hospital, Coimbatore to perform postmortem as per the general guidelines and procedures described in paragraphs 606-641 in section – II, Chapter XVI of Tamil Nadu Medical Code except paras 609 & 633 which are applicable to Chennai city only.

2. The Dean, Government Medical College and ESI Hospital, Coimbatore in his letter second read above addressed to the District Collector, Coimbatore with a copy marked to Government has stated that Government Order has been received to conduct autopsy in their institution and conducting autopsy is mandatory for the academic purpose as well as to fulfill the National Medical Council Norms. As Chennai Jurisdiction has been divided for 4 Medical Colleges for the convenience of the Public and Police, Coimbatore Police Jurisdiction may also be divided into two

jurisdictions for the benefit of the students, Public and Police Department. The Dean, Government Medical College and ESI Hospital, Coimbatore has further stated that request has been already sent to the Director of Medical Education, Chennai which has been transmitted to the Director General of Police, Chennai in this regard. The Dean, Government Medical College and ESI Hospital, Coimbatore has therefore requested to take necessary steps to identify jurisdiction for their institution.

- 3. In the Government letter third read above, the District Collector, Coimbatore was requested to convene a meeting with Commissioner of Police, Superintendent of Police, Deans of Government Medical and ESI College and other officers and to take necessary steps on the above request of the Dean, Government Medical College and ESI Hospital, Coimbatore as per rules and send necessary proposals to the Government.
- 4. In the letter fourth read above, the District Collector, Coimbatore has stated that meeting was conducted with all the stakeholders on 07.06.2022 at 4.00 PM. It has been instructed to send the proposal for bifurcation of jurisdiction for conduct of both medico legal and non-medico legal post mortem to be taken up in the following institutions in Coimbatore District.
 - (i) Government Coimbatore Medical College & Hospital, Coimbatore.
 - (ii) Government Medical College & ESI Hospital, Singanallur, Coimbatore.
- 5. The District Collector, Coimbatore has further stated that the Commissioner of Police and the Superintendent of Police has sent the proposals that the Medico Legal jurisdiction of the following police stations may be bifurcated to both the Government Colleges as below:-

- 6. The District Collector, Coimbatore has therefore forwarded the proposals of the Commissioner of Police and the Superintendent of Police for passing necessary orders to bifurcate the jurisdiction and allow Government Medical College and ESI Hospital, Coimbatore to perform medico legal autopsy and requested early orders of the Government in this regard.
- 7. Further, the Dean, Government Medical College and ESI Hospital, Coimbatore in his letter fifth read above has stated that sufficient infrastructure, faculty and equipments / facilities are available in the Department of Forensic Medicine to conduct the Medico Legal Autopsy in Government Medical College and ESI Hospital, Coimbatore.
- 8. The Government after careful examination decide to accept the proposal of the District Collector, Coimbatore to bifurcate the jurisdiction proposed at para 5 above and to allow Government Medical College and ESI Hospital, Coimbatore to perform medico legal autopsy and orders accordingly.
- 9. This order issues with the concurrence of the Home Department vide its U.O.No.39281/Home(Police-.XIV)/2022-1, dated 05.07.2022.
