ORDER:

In Government Order sixth read above, permission was accorded to the Chairman, Sree Pankajam Krishnan Educational Trust at Krishnagiri District for starting a new College of Nursing in the name and style as "Jeeva College of Nursing" at Krishnagiri District to conduct B.Sc Nursing course with an annual intake of 50 students from the academic year 2011-2012.

2. The Chairman, Sree Pankajam Krishnan Educational Trust, Krishnagiri has requested the Government to grant permission to enhance the seats in B.Sc Nursing course from 50 to 100 from the academic year 2019-2020 at Jeeva College of Nursing, Krishnagiri.

3. In its Government letter seventh read above, the Director of Medical Education was requested to conduct an inspection on the premises of the Trust for considering their request. Accordingly, the Director of Medical Education has constituted an inspection team to verify as to whether the proposed nursing college has fulfilled the conditions prescribed by the Government in the Government Orders first to five read above and the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi.

4. In his letter eighth read above, the Director of Medical Education has submitted the proposal in which he has stated that the inspection team has conducted an inspection at the premises and submitted their report by stating that the said institution has fulfilled all the norms prescribed by the Government as well as by the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi. Hence, the Director of Medical Education has recommended to give permission to the Chairman, Sree Pankajam Krishnan Educational Trust, Krishnagiri to enhance the seats in B.Sc Nursing course from 50 to 100 from the academic year 2019-2020 at Jeeva College of Nursing, Krishnagiri.

5. The Government have examined the case in detail in the light of the Inspection Report and the recommendations of the Director of Medical Education and decided to grant permission to the Chairman, Sree Pankajam Krishnan Educational Trust, Krishnagiri to enhance the seats in B.Sc (Nursing) course from 50 to 100 at Jeeva College of Nursing, Krishnagiri in S.F.No.84/2A, 84/2B, 4B, 4C, 4D, Puliyanjeri Village, Beemandapalli Panchayat, Veppanapalli Union, Krishnagiri from the academic year 2019-2020. Accordingly, the Government do and hereby direct that the Chairman, Sree Pankajam Krishnan Educational Trust, Krishnagiri is permitted to enhance the seats in B.Sc (Nursing) course from 50(fifty) to 100 (one hundred) at Jeeva College of Nursing, Krishnagiri in S.F.No.84/2A, 84/2B, 4B, 4C, 4D, Puliyanjeri Village, Beemandapalli Panchayat, Veppanapalli Union, Krishnagiri from the academic year 2019-2020, subject to the following conditions:-

- a) The Trust should obtain the planning permission from the Directorate of Town and Country Planning for construction of building to the extent of 4500 Sq.ft and to complete the construction before admitting the students.
- b) The Trust should construct 3 class rooms with 1800 sq.ft for accommodating 100 students.

- c) The Trust should obtain the planning permission from the Directorate of Town and Country Planning for construction of building to the extent of 6264 Sq.ft has proposed and should construct 17000 Sq.ft additional building for hostel facilities after obtaining the planning permission from the Directorate of Town and Country Planning.
- d) The Trust should construct 200 bedded own hospital within a period of three years, since the Trust is already having the 100 bedded own hospital.
- e) The Trust should obtain the building plan approval from the Directorate of Town and Country Planning (DTCP) and building completion certificate from the competent authority for the proposed Nursing College and submit to the Government before admitting the students.
- f) Admission of students shall be made as per the rules fixed by the Government from time to time.
- g) Tuition fees including special fees should be collected from the students at the same rates as prescribed by the Government from time to time. The Management should also give separate undertaking stating that No CAPITATION FEE or any other fund in the name of building fund, etc. will be collected from the students seeking admission in the Private Self Financing Nursing Colleges.
- h) The Trust should obtain recognition / affiliation from the Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council, Chennai, and Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University and if needed, suitability from Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi, respectively before admitting the students.
- i) The Government have the right to utilize the Government Endowment fund created by the Trust in meeting the justifiable payment to students that may arise due to non compliance of rules and regulations of the Government by the Trust like winding of course without valid reasons etc.
- j) The Institute so permitted to conduct the course will be allowed to shift / change the study centres only after completion of three years from the date of actual commencement of the course by the first batch of students, after getting orders of Government on inspection of the centres.

6. The Director of Medical Education is directed to take necessary further action accordingly.
