ORDER:

In the Government Orders first, second and third read above, orders were issued for the fixation of Expected Level of Demand under Sterilization, IUCD, OP Users and CC Users for the year 2010-2011 to 2013-2014 respectively.

2. The Director of Family Welfare in his letter fourth read above has informed that in the G.O.(D) No.1017, Health and Family Welfare (R1) Department, dated:20.09.2013 orders have been issued for the fixation of Expected Level of Demand (ELD) under Sterilization, IUCD, Oral Pill (OP) Users and Conventional Contraception (CC) Users to the districts for the year 2013-14 as follows:-

 Sterilization
 3,65,000

 IUCD
 3,90,000

 OP Users
 1,50,000

 CC Users
 1,80,000

- 3. Further the Director of Family Welfare has stated that it is proposed to fix the Expected Level of Demand under the Family Welfare methods for the year 2014-15 with a view to achieve the following objectives:
 - i. Reduction of Higher order births.
 - ii. Meeting the Unmet needs in Contraception.
 - iii. Raising the Couple Protection Rate (CPR)

- iv. Enhancing and Ensuring the Quality of Family Welfare services through the adoption of guidelines of the Government of India in the performance of sterilization and reduction of number of details due to sterilization.
- 4. The Director of Family Welfare has also stated that the Expected Level of Demand under Family Welfare methods to the districts for the year 2014-15 have been calculated based on the following parameters:-
 - (i) Higher order Births for 2011.
 - (ii) Average of last 3 years performance of the districts under family welfare methods.
 - (iii) District-wise Unmet need
 - (iv) District-wise Total Fertility Rate (TFR)
- 5. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of Director of Family Welfare. Accordingly, the Government fix the Districtwise Expected Level of Demand under Sterilization NSV, IUCD, PPIUCD and Conventional Contraceptive (CC) Users for the year 2014-15 as indicated in the Annexure to this order. The District Collectors are requested to take all necessary steps to achieve the Expected Level of Demand under Family Welfare Programme in respect of their districts for the year 2014-15.
- 6. The Director of Family Welfare is directed to review the progress made in each District periodically with a view to achieve the Expected Level of Demand in all Districts and to take appropriate remedial measures whenever the Expected Level of Demand is not achieved and send quarterly report to the Government.
