ORDER:

The system of Birth and Death Registration has been revamped from 1.01.2000 and the Tamil Nadu Registration of Birth and Death Rules 2000 have been notified in the G.O. first read above under the revamped system of Birth and Death Registration, Form 1 to Form 15 to be used in the registration process which have been also notified as in the G.O. first and second read above.

2. In the letter 4th read above, the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has requested the Government to issue an amendment to the rule 5 of Tamil Nadu Registration of Birth and Death Rules, 2000 by incorporating the new Form IA in the system of, communicated by the Registrar General of the India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India in the letter third read above.

3. The Government after examination, accept the amendment, proposed by the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine and Publish in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 30 of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act 1969 (Central Act 18 of 1969) the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment, to the Tamil Nadu Registration of Births and Deaths Rules, 2000 published dated page 976 of part III Section 1 (a) SRO No.A 95 (a) 99 of Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extra Ordinary dated 29.12.1999 and also published at page 64 of Part-III Section 1 (a) of SRO No. A 28/2003 of Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extra Ordinary dated 28.05.2003.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules:-

For the following existing Rule 5 – Form for giving information of births and Deaths:

(i) The information required to be given to the Registrar under section 8 or section 9, as the case may be, shall be in Form Nos. 1, 2, and 3 for the Registration of a birth, death and still birth respectively, herein after to be collectively called the reporting forms. Information, if given orally, shall be entered by the Registrar in the appropriate reporting form and the signature (or) thumb impression of the informant obtained.

The following shall be substituted :

The information required to be given to the Registrar under sec 8 or sec 9 as the case may be, shall be in Form-1, Form 1A, Form 2 and Form 3 for registration of birth, adoption of child, death and Still birth respectively herein after to be collectively called the reporting forms. Information if given orally shall be entered by the Registrar in the appropriate reporting forms and the signature / thumb impression of the informant to obtained.
