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### ORDER :

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued fixing the rate of stipend to the Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship trainees (CRRIs) and Post Graduate Medical students with an automatic yearly increase of Rs.300/- in the monthly stipend paid to Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees (CRRIs) and Rs.600/- to Post Graduate / Higher Specialty students with effect from 01.07.2009 as follows:-

2. In their representation second read above, the Interns and Post Graduates Association of Tamil Nadu has requested the Government to enhance the stipend being paid to them.

3. The Government, after careful consideration, have decided to enhance the rate of stipend to the CRRIs and Post Graduate Degree / Diploma and Higher Specialty / 6 year M.Ch. (Neuro Surgery) students from 01.04.2014 as detailed below:
