ORDER:-

The Director of Medical Education in his letter read above has stated among others that the Dean, Government Stanley Medical College and Hospital, Chennai has stated that the Institute for Research and Rehabilitation of Hand and Department of Plastic Surgery at Government Stanley Medical College and Hospital, Chennai is the Centre of Excellence for Hand and Micro Vascular Surgery. It is functioning with the two storey building separately, which was constructed in 2003 and since then serving many hand injury patients from various industries due to work-spot injury and due to road traffic accident and also general plastic surgery cases. They have got licensed for Hand Transplant and they have done the Tamil Nadu's first bilateral Hand Transplant on 07.02.2018. He has submitted further justifications as follows:-

- 1) For the improvement of post-operative monitoring of the patient along with immunotherapy they need to improve the infrastructure.
- 2) Hand transplant patients have to be encouraged to do physiotherapy for better functioning of the transplanted hand. For this purpose, some physiotherapy equipments are required.
- 3) The prosthetic hand, which is fit into the donor's body is custom made in our department splint section. The machines are all worn out in that section, which needs to be changed for better fitting prosthetic hand. Later dynamic splint are given for mobilisation of the joints. They have to be made in the department splint section itself.
- 4) Hand transplant surgery poses a lot of challenges for wellbeing of the patient. To be on anti-microbial support and for the improvement of ICU, the need of microvascular instrument and microscope for the operation theatres along with other instruments are required.

2. The Director of Medical Education has further state that the existing Operation Theatre (OT) also has to be revamped as modular OT with epoxide flooring and laminar flow and with 8.5 TR air cooling unit. This will prevent post operative infection by providing sterile air flow during this prolonged surgery. Further, to continue this program of Hand Transplantation, there is definite need for all the equipment as non recurring expenditure. All the post operative patients require dressing which are autoclaved in department itself. There is a separate dressing OT in OP as "A" dressing for non infective cases and "C" dressing for infected cases. Hence, there is a requirement for bulk dressing materials in the department. Further the existing autoclave inner drums are bulging and the Service Engineer has opined that it is almost near condemnation. Hence, 2 big and 2 small autoclave are required to prepare sterile dressings for these patients.

3. The Director of Medical Education has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.4,23,92,445/- (Rupees four crore twenty three lakh ninety two thousand four hundred and forty five only) towards the procurement of the following machinery and equipments, stores and equipments and medicine to the Institute for Research and Rehabilitation of Hand and Department of Plastic Surgery, Government Stanley Medical College and Hospital, Chennai.

4. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and decided to accept the same. Accordingly, the Government do and hereby accorded sanction for a sum of Rs.4,23,92,445/- (Rupees Four crores twenty three lakh ninety two thousand four hundred and forty five only) towards the procurement of the following machinery and equipments, stores and equipments and medicine to the Institute for Research and Rehabilitation of Hand and Department of Plastic Surgery, Government Stanley Medical College and Hospital, Chennai.

The Director of Medical Education is authorized to purchase the equipments and medicines mentioned at para 4 above through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited, and authorized to draw and deposit the amount sanctioned in para 4 above to the Personal Deposit Account of the Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited, Chennai by means of Cheque / Demand Draft in favour of Personal Deposit Account of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para-4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by draw of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Director of Medical Education is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G.I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G.I) Department. The Director of Medical Education is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2018-2019 to Finance (B.G.I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
