ORDER:-

The Director of Medical Education, in his letter first read above, had stated that under the scheme of National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries (NPPMBI), the following Government Medical College Hospitals have been identified in the State of Tamil Nadu for establishing the Burns Unit:-

- i. Thanjavur Medical College Hospital, Thanjavur.
- ii. KAP Viswanatham Government Medical College and Mahatma Gandhi Memorial Government Hospital, Trichy.

2. The Government of India has agreed to sanction a sum of Rs.6.579 crore for establishing the Burn Unit (including civil works, equipment and manpower for 3 years) to the Government Thanjavur Medical College, Thanjavur with the sharing pattern of 75:25 percentage of Central and State share. The grants will be

provided for the following purposes under the National Programme for Prevention and management of Burn Injuries:-

3. In their letter second read above, though the Government of India had released Rs.2.599 crore, under the "National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries" Scheme, the said amount had not been reached to the Government of Tamil Nadu for establishing Burns Unit at Government Thanjavur Medical College Hospital, Thanjavur. Hence, the Government had accorded the administrative sanction alone to the above said amount in the Government Order third read above.

4. The Government of India, in their letter fourth read above, has released the payment of a sum of Rs.2,07,90,000/- (Rupees Two crore seven lakh and ninety thousand only) towards the first instalment (60% Central share) (the Government of India has revised the sharing pattern from 75:25 into that of 60:40 Central and State share) towards construction (Rs.1.305 crore) and procurement of equipment (Rs.0.774 crore) to "Thanjavur Medical College and Hospital in Tamil Nadu under the Scheme of "National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries (NPPMBI)" in the revised sharing pattern 60:40 (Central : State share) and released the said amount to the Government of Tamil Nadu.

5. In his letter fifth read above, the Director of Medical Education has countersigned and forwarded the rough cost estimate prepared by the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Trichy Region, for construction of Burns Unit at Thanjavur Medical College Hospital, Thanjavur under the "National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries at a cost of Rs.217.50 lakh for the year 2016-2017 and at a cost of Rs.228.50 lakh for the year 2017-2018. He has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary administrative and financial sanction of Rs.2.175 crore for the construction of Burns Unit.

6. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Medical Education, accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.3,46,50,000/- (Rupees Three crore forty six lakh and fifty thousand only) (Central Share - Rs.2,07,90,000/- and State Share - Rs.1,38,60,000/) towards construction of building at a cost of Rs.2,17,50,000/- (Rupees Two crore seventeen lakh and fifty thousand only) and purchase of equipment at a total cost Rs.1,29,00,000/- (Rupees one crore and twenty nine lakh only) for establishing a Burns Unit at Thanjavur Medical College Hospital, Thanjavur under National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries (NPPMBI) with the sharing pattern between Government of India and State Government of Tamil Nadu as 60 : 40, respectively.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following Heads of accounts in the Budget Estimate 2018-2019:-

i) Purchase of Equipments:-

"2210. Medical and Public Health – 01. Urban Health Services - Allopathy – 110. Hospitals and Dispensaries – Schemes shared between State and Centre – UD. National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries (NPPMBI) – 19. Machinery and Equipment – 01. Purchase" (DPC 2210 – 01 – 110 – UD - 1912)

ii) Construction of Buildings:-

"4210 – Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01 - Urban Health Services – 200 – Other Health Schemes – Schemes shared between State and Centre – UB National Programme for Prevention and Management of Burn Injuries (NPPMBI) – 16 Major works. (DPC 4210 01 200 UB 1608)

8. The Director of Medical Education is directed to procure the equipments in the sanctioned amount of Rs.1,29,00,000/- through the Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation. Hence, he has directed to draw and deposit the above said amount in the following Personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited for procuring the equipments:-

"K. Deposits and Advances - (b). Deposits not bearing interest – 8443.00. – Civil Deposits – 800. Other Deposits – CE. Deposits of Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited (TNMSC). (DPC 8443 – 00 – 800 – CE – 00 OH (Receipts))".

9. The Director of Medical Education is directed to execute the construction works through Public Works Department. He is authorized to draw and disburse amount sanction in para 6 above for construction of building (Rs.2,17,50,000/-) to the Chief Engineer (Building), Chennai.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department, vide its U.O. No.31113/Health-II/2018, dated 21.06.2018.
