ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, among others, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.2.45 crore to carry out the activities of non-recurring components of "Integrated working model to identify, prevent and set base for neglected paediatric disorders – care of Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy (DMD)" Project under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives for the year 2015-18.

2. In the G.O second read above, the Government have approved the recurring component of the above said project at a total cost of Rs.11.67 crore for the years 2015 -16 (Rs.4.68 crore) and 2016-2017 (Rs.6.99 crore) from the State budget. Further, in the said Government Order, the Government directed the Mission Director, National Rural Health Mission to take up the proposal with National Health Mission for funding the recurring cost of Rs.4.57 crore for the third year project.

3. In the letter third read above, the Mission Director, National Health Mission has informed that necessary funds cannot be obtained from National Health Mission funds, as per the orders issued in G.O(Ms)No.124, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated: 4.3.2016, since, it was not recommended in Program Implementation Plan 2019-20 of National Health Mission citing the reasons that, the said activity is not covered under 30 conditions of Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram program.

4. The Government have examined the proposal in detail and decided to consider the 3rd year recurring cost of Rs.4,57,00,000/- (Rupees four crore and fifty seven lakh only) under State fund so as to complete the Project of working model to identify, prevent and set base for neglected paediatric disorders – care of Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy (DMD) in time. Accordingly, the Government have accorded sanction for a sum of Rs.4,57,00,000/- (Rupees four crore and fifty seven lakh only) towards the recurring cost of the 3rd year project "An Integrated working model to identify, prevent and set base for treatment for neglected paediatric disorders – Care of Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy".

5. The amount sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited under the following Head of account.

"2211-00 Family Welfare – 103- Maternity and Child Health- States Expenditure -JQ-Care of Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy(DMD) Project-309- Grants in aid-03-Grants for specific schemes"

6. The expenditure sanctioned in Para - 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawl of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Mission Director, National Health Mission – Tamilnadu, is directed to apply for sanction of advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG.I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. The Mission Director, National Health Mission- Tamilnadu, is requested to send draft explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2020-2021 to Finance (BG.I/Health.I) Department without fail.
