ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued for the establishment of a new Government Medical College and Hospital at Karur with an annual intake of 150 students from the academic year 2016-2017.

2. In the Government Order second read above, orders have been accorded Administrative and Financial sanction for a sum of Rs.229,46,00,000/- towards construction of new Government Medical College and Hospital buildings at Karur.

3. In his letter third read above, the Director of Medical Education, has forwarded the Revised Administrative Sanction proposal for a sum of Rs.269,58,32,448/- received from the Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chennai towards construction of new Government Medical College and Hospital buildings at Karur and he has requested the Government to accord revised administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.269,58,32,448/- against the original sanction of Rs.229,46,00,000/-. The Revised Administrative sanction proposal prepared by the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department countersigned by the Director of Medical Education. The additional cost has been arrived for an amount of Rs.40.13 crores.

The Tender Award Committee in its 274<sup>th</sup> meeting on 03.01.2018 has approved the revised administrative sanction proposal for a sum of Rs.269,58,32,448/- towards construction of new Government Medical College and Hospital buildings at Karur against the original administrative sanction of Rs.229,46,00,000/- with an instruction that there should not be any further Revised Administrative Sanction and the decision arrived at by the Committee are subject to accuracy, correctness and genuineness of all informative data furnished by the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai.

5. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and accord Revised Administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.269,58,32,448/- (Rupees Two hundred and sixty nine crore fifty eight lakh thirty two thousand four hundred and forty eight only) i.e, an additional expenditure of Rs.40,12,32,448/- (Rupees forty crore twelve lakh and thirty two thousand and four hundred and forty eight only) for construction of New Government Medical College and Hospital at Karur against the original sanction amount of Rs.229,46,00,000/- with an instruction that there should not be any further revised administrative sanction and subject to accuracy, correctness and genuineness of all informative data furnished by the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Work Department, Chennai.

6. The expenditure sanction in para 5 above shall be debited to following Head of Account:-

"4210 – Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01 – Urban Health Services – 110 – Hospitals and Dispensaries (Including Pharmacy) – State's Expenditure – JA Buildings – 16 Major Works". (DPC 4210 – 01 – 110 – JA - 1602)".

7. The additional expenditure of Rs.40,12,32,448/- sanctioned in para-5 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG.I) Department directly in Form A appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG.I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2018-2019 to Finance (BG.I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.31072/Health-II/2018, Dated: 25.06.2018 and ASL No.511 (five hundred and eleven).
