ORDER:

In the letters read above, the Mission Director, National Health Mission has stated that the Director of Medical Education had submitted a proposal to Government to strengthen the Maternity Wings of Medical Colleges by increasing the unit strength of the Obstetric Specialists by appointing 27 Obstetricians and 18 Emergency Obstetric Care (EmOC) trained Medical Officers which was included in the PIP 2014-15 by the State Health Society and approved by the Government of India. The proposal (Agenda No.07) has been approved in the 27th Executive Committee Meeting

- 2. The Mission Director, National Health Mission has also stated that proper orders have been obtained regarding change of nomenclature for the 18 posts from Emergency Obstetric Care trained Medical Officers to Senior Residents (Anesthesia) within the approved budget in same scale of pay without causing any additional expenditure to the Government. The justification for the change in nomenclature is that as per the directive of TAEI, more number of Anaesthetists are required to fulfil various surgical specialties in Medical College Hospitals.

The Director of Medical Education is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2018-19 to Finance (BG.I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
