Announcement made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister – Construction of Residential Quarters (30 Residents) and Lecture Hall (400 students) at Government Thiruvarur Medical College, Thiruvarur – Administrative and financial sanction – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

The Hon'ble Chief Minister has made an announcement on 25.08.2015, under Rule 110 of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rules, among others, a sum of Rs.4.63 crore will be sanctioned for the construction of Residential Quarters at Government Chengalpattu Medical College, Chengalpattu and a sum of Rs.3.15 crore will be sanctioned for the construction of Residential Quarters for 30 students and Lecture Hall for 400 students at Government Thiruvarur Medical College, Thiruvarur.

2. The Director of Medical Education in the letters read above, has sent the proposal for construction of Residential Quarters (30 Residents) and Lecture Hall (400 students) at Government Thiruvarur Medical College, Thiruvarur.

3. The Director of Medical Education has stated that the proposed building for Residential Quarters for Junior Residents / Senior Residents (30 Residents) under Phase-II works has been designed for ultimate Ground Floor+3 Floors and each floor can accommodate 8 Residents and the building has been proposed to construct near the Residential Quarters.

4. The Director of Medical Education has furnished the following details for the construction of Residential Quarters (30 Residents) and Lecture Hall (400 students) at Thiruvarur Medical College, Thiruvarur:-

She has stated that considering future expansion of the college, construction of building for 400 seated Lecture Hall and 30 resident rooms (Junior Residents / Senior Residents) have been proposed. She has also stated that the proposal for the construction of Residential Quarters is for residents only (Junior Residents / Senior Residents) and not for students.

5. The Director of Medical Education has countersigned and forwarded the rough cost estimate prepared by the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Trichy, based on the schedule of rates for the year 2015-2016 and requested the Government to accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.127.60 lakh for the construction of Residential Quarters (30 Residents) and Rs.187.00 lakh for the construction of Lecturer Hall (400 students) at Government Thiruvarur Medical College, Thiruvarur.

6. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Medical Education, accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.3,14,60,000/- (Rupees three crore fourteen lakh and sixty thousand only) for the following works to Government Thiruvarur Medical College, Thiruvarur in the schedule of rates for the year 2015-2016 as detailed below:-

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

“4210 – Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services – 110 – Hospitals and Dispensaries (Including Pharmacy) Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II State Plan – JA Buildings - 16 Major Works.” (DPC 4210-01-110-JA -1602)

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall constitute an item of “New Instrument of Service” and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is

directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary estimate and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the supplementary estimate for the year 2015-2016 to Finance Department at the appropriate time without fail.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.43772/Health-II/2015, dated:11.08.2015 and ASL No.714 (Seven hundred and fourteen).
