ORDER:-

In the order first read above, the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court among others in para 51 (xii) has directed as follows:-

- (xii) "The Government should appoint Scientific Officers in all the Government Medical College Hospitals and in every District headquarters. The qualification, duties and responsibilities for the post of Scientific Officers shall be defined by the Government with the assistance of a Committee of Experts constituted by the Government consisting of experts in Forensic Science, Criminology and medical examination and in other fields as may be suggested by the Forensic Department. The State Government is directed to constitute a Committee of Experts within six months and the appointment of required number of Scientific Officers should be made within one year after the qualifications and duties and responsibilities of the Scientific Officer are defined by the Committee of Experts."
- 2. The Director of Medical Education in the letter second read above has stated that during the meeting held in the chamber of Principal Secretary to Government, Health and Family Welfare Department, Secretariat, Chennai on 25.08.2022 a decision was taken to reconstitute an Expert Committee with the following officials to comply with the direction issued by Hon'ble High Court in

Para 51 (xii) of the order dated 28.09.2020 in W.P(MD)No.78 of 2019, regarding appointment of Scientific Officers in all Government Medical College Hospitals.

The Government further direct that the committee shall submit its report to Government on the feasibility for appointment of Scientific Officers in all the Government Medical College Hospitals and District Headquarters Hospitals duly prescribing the qualification, duties and responsibilities in compliance of the orders

of Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court dated 28.09.2020 in W.P (MD) No.78 of 2019 within a period of two months.

5. The Director of Medical Education is directed to make all coordinating arrangement for conducting the meeting of the Committee and finalisation of its report.
