ORDER:

As per the decisions arrived during the 3rd meeting of the Experts Committee held on 4.10.2017 for implementation of Guidelines for fire safety methods in the existing hospital buildings, the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services, Member-Secretary of the Committee, has requested the Public Works Department authorities to prepare rough cost estimate to provide Ramp facilities in the existing hospital buildings of the Government Medical College Hospitals.

2. In his letter above, the Director of Medical Education has stated that the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region has prepared the rough cost estimate to provide Ramp facilities in the existing hospital buildings of the certain Government Medical College Hospitals, works out to Rs.864.70 lakhs, duly countersigned by the Director of Medical Education:-

3. The Director of Medical Education has therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.864.70 lakh to provide Ramp facilities in the existing hospital buildings of the Government Medical College Hospitals/ Institutions.

4. In the meantime, the Hon'ble Minister for Health and Family Welfare has made the following announcement on the floor of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly during the Budget Session held on 14.06.2018:-

The Government after careful examination of the proposal of Director of Medical Education in detail and decided to accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.6.365 crore (Rupees Six crore thirty six lakh and fifty thousand only) to provide Ramp facilities in the following Government Medical College Hospitals.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following Head of account:-

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to the Finance (BG.I) Department directly, in Form-"A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963, along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from the Finance (BG.I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2018-2019 to the Finance (BG.I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
