ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, among others, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.1,60,00,000/- for the procurement of Extra Corporeal Short Wave Lithotripsy (ESWL) Machine to Coimbatore Medical College Hospital, Coimbatore. In Government Order second read above, among others, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.1,45,00,000/- for the procurement of Extra Corporeal Short Wave Lithotripsy (ESWL) Machine to Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital, Tirunelveli.

2. The Director of Medical Education, in the letter third read above, has sent the proposal for sanction of additional funds towards the procurement of Extra Corporeal Short Wave Lithotripsy (ESWL) Machine to the Government Medical College Hospitals of Coimbatore and Tirunelveli.

3. The Director of Medical Education has stated that the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited, Chennai has requested to sanction the additional funds of Rs.2,46,77,514/- towards the procurement of ESWL Machine to the Government Medical College Hospitals of Coimbatore and Tirunelveli as against the amount of Rs.3,05,00,000/- already sanctioned by the Government for the procurement of said equipment. The Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited has stated that as the exchange rate of Euro has gone up by 41.71% from 2007 to 2014 and by 16.98% from 2009 to 2014, the sanctioned fund of Rs.1.60 crore

for the equipment to Coimbatore Medical College Hospital and Rs.1.45 crore to Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital are grossly insufficient and hence there is a need for sanction of additional funds. The details of additional funds required are as follows:-

4. The Director of Medical Education has, therefore, requested the Government to sanction the additional amount of Rs.2,46,77,514/- required for the procurement of ESWL Machine to the Medical College Hospitals of Coimbatore and Tirunelveli as against the amount of Rs. 3,05,00,000/- already sanctioned by the Government.

5. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Medical Education, accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.2,46,77,514/- (Rupees two crore forty six lakh seventy seven thousand five hundred and fourteen only) required for the procurement of ESWL Machine to the Medical College Hospitals of Coimbatore and Tirunelveli.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be met out of the funds provided in the Budget Estimate 2015-2016 under the following head of account:-

“2210 – Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services – Allopathy – 110 Hospitals and Dispensaries – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II State Plan – JJ Improvements to Teaching Hospitals – 19 Machinery and Equipments – 01 Purchase.”
(DPC 2210 – 01 – 110 – JJ - 1911)

If the Budget Estimate 2015-2016 provisions are inadequate, the Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme funds shall be used.

7. The Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and deposit the amount sanctioned in para 5 above to the Personal Deposit account of the Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited, Chennai by means of Cheque/Demand Draft in favour of Personal Deposit account of the Managing Director, the Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited.

8. The Director of Medical Education is further informed that the amount shall not be paid in cash but credited to the following Personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited:-

“K Deposit and Advances (b) Deposits not bearing Interest – 8443 00 – Civil Deposit – 800 Other Deposits – CE Deposits of Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited.”
