National Health Mission – State Health Society – Tamil Nadu – Placing of 222 Security guards in 47 Medical Institutions (22 Medical College Hospitals and 25 CEmONC Centres) through outsourcing mode – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister, Health and Family Welfare Department has announced on the floor of the Assembly that 222 security Guards will be appointed in 47 high performing CEmONC centers for the safety of mothers and newborns at a cost of Rs.1.33 crore. Of late, it is seen in news / media that newborn babies have been stolen by antisocial elements from the Government Medical Institution for their personal gains. This can be avoided by controlling the visitors by posting security guards properly at the entrance of Labour ward. In order to rectify the above mentioned problems, it has been proposed that security personnel exclusively may be posted to watch and control the crowd round the clock (24*7) in full vigil condition in this regard.

2. The Medical Institutions which includes the 47 CEmONC centers in the state which performs more than 150 Deliveries / month including 22 Medical College Institutions may be considered for appointing the Security Guard in the first phase in the State. An estimated number of 2,00,000 PN mothers & New borns would be benefited upon appointing the Security Guards.

3. The above proposal was placed in PIP 2018 – 2019 and has been approved in Record of Proceedings.

4. The breakup details of the proposed 47 Medical Institutions are as follows:

The funds for the salary cost for security guards can be met from funds released to District Health Society as per existing National Health Mission norms.

5. The Mission Director, National Health Mission has requested necessary orders in this regard.

6. The Government after careful examination has decided to accept the proposal of the Mission Director, State Health Society and permit the Mission Director, National Health Mission to place 222 Security Guards at the pay of Rs.6500/- per month through outsourcing mode through the concerned Dean/Joint Director of Health Services in 22 Medical College Hospitals and 25 CEmONC Centres in Labour wards as detailed below:-
