ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued approving the selection of 29 candidates provisionally made by Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. Subsequently, eleven candidates have been sponsored by the Commission and the orders of approval have been issued in Government orders second, third and fourth read above.

- 2. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine in his letter fifth read above has reported that among the 40 candidates, 11 candidates have been removed from the approval list by the Government for non-joining of duty. In the remaining 29 candidates, 24 candidates are in service and completed Orientation Training Course at the Institute of Public Health, Poonamallee, Chennai and joined duty as Health Officer in Tamil Nadu Public Health Service. He has further requested the Government to regularize the services of the 24 Health Officer in Tamil Nadu Public Health Service as per section 3(o)(i) of Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016.
- 3. The Government, after careful examination direct that the temporary services of the following 24 Health Officers in the Tamil Nadu Public Health Service

be regularized under section 3(o)(i) of Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 with effect from the date of their joining in the Orientation Training Course as indicated against their names:-
