### ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister for Health and Family Welfare Department for announced on the floor of the Assembly that Special New born Care Units (SNCU) at Government Medical College Hospital Coimbatore will be upgraded at a cost of Rs.2.09 crore. Strengthening of Special New born Care Units (SNCUs) is one of the core activities in the State for reducing the neonatal deaths. Since the advent of National Health Mission, more than 64 Special New born Care Units have been established and functioning. However, due to ever increasing demand for neonatal care services in the Special New born Care Units, it has become a necessity to upgrade the Special New born Care Units with provisions of additional buildings to them. Thus, it has proposed to provide additional buildings to Special New born Care Units in Government Medical College Hospital, Coimbatore at a total cost of Rs. 209 lakh including furniture and equipment (ie., Rs.150 lakh for civil works + Rs. 59 lakh for furniture and equipment).

- 2. In this regard, a detailed proposal has been included in PIP 2018-19. The proposal is approved in Record of Proceedings 2018-19 by the National Program Coordination Committee (NPCC) of Government of India, for providing additional building to Special New born Care Units in Government Medical College Hospital, Coimbatore with a budgetary provisions of Rs. 40 lakhs for the year 2018-19. The balance of funds required in this regard, is to be proposed in subsequent PIPs.
- 3. The above proposal has been approved by the Executive Committee in 35<sup>th</sup> Executive Committee meeting held on 16.5.2018.
- 4. The Mission Director, National Health Mission has stated the funds Rs. 40 lakh approved for the year 2018-19, for constructing additional Buildings to Special New born Care Units in Government Medical College Hospital, Coimbatore at the total cost of Rs.209 lakh including civil works and procurement of furniture and equipment cost is remitted into Government Account, as per the directions issued in G.O(Ms) No. 116, Health and Family Welfare (EAP II -2) department, dated

25.03.2011 and remitted fund has to be sanctioned for the execution of works through Public Works Department.

- 5. The Mission Director, National Health Mission, has requested necessary orders in this regard.
- 6. The Government after careful examination of the above proposal decided to accept and accordingly issue following orders:
  - i. The Mission Director, State Health Society Tamil Nadu, Chennai is permitted to construct additional Buildings through Public Works Department and procure furniture and equipment through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation to Special New born Care Units in Coimbatore Medical College Hospital at a total cost of Rs. 209 lakh (Rs. 150 lakh for civil work + Rs. 59 lakh for furniture and equipment).
  - ii. Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.40 lakh (Rupees forty lakh only) for executing the civil works through Public Works Department.
  - The Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings) Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai is permitted to issue orders to the Executive Engineers of the concerned divisions for the drawal of funds under the head of account "4211 00 103 SA 1606".
  - iv. The Mission Director, is permitted to remit the balance of funds required for the above said civil works as and when the funds are approved by Government of India.
- 7. The amount sanctioned in para 6(ii) above shall be debited to the following. Head of account

"4211-00 capital outlay on Family Welfare – 103 Maternity and Child Health State's Expenditure – AA civil works under National Health Mission Scheme- 16 Major works".
