## ORDER:

- 2. A detailed proposal has been included in PIP 2018-19. The proposal is approved in the Record of Proceedings 2018-19 by the Government of India with the budgetary provision of Rs.60 lakh for 2018-2019, at 10% of the total cost of Rs.600 lakh for constructing Modern Out Patient Block in Government Hospital of Thoracic Medicine, Tambaram, Kancheepuram District. The civil works has to be executed through Public Works Department. The balance of funds required in this regard are to be proposed in the subsequent PIPs.
- 3. The sum Rs.60 lakh approved for the year 2018-19, for constructing Modern Out Patient Block (including furniture) in Government Hospital of Thoracic Medicine, Tambaram, Kancheepuram District has been remitted into Government Account, as per the directions issued in G.O(Ms)No.116, Health and Family Welfare (EAP-II-2) Department, dated 25.03.2011 and remitted fund has to be sanctioned for the execution of works through Public Works Department.
  - 4. The above proposal has been approved by the Executive Committee
- 5. The Mission Director, National Health Mission has therefore requested necessary Government orders in this regard.

- 6. The Government after careful consideration have decided to accept the proposal of the Mission Director, State Health Society and accordingly issue following orders:
  - i. The Mission Director, is permitted to construct Modern Out Patient Block (with furniture) in Government Hospital of Thoracic Medicine, Tambaram, Kancheepuram District under National Health Mission, at a total cost of Rs. 6.00 crore for civil works and furniture.
  - ii. Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs. 60 lakh (Rupees Sixty lakh only) for executing the above civil works through Public Works Department.
- iii. The Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings) Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai is permitted to issue orders to the Executive Engineers of the concerned divisions for the drawal of funds.
- iv. The Mission Director, State Health Society Tamil Nadu, Chennai is permitted to remit the balance of funds required for the above said civil works including furniture as and when the funds are approved by Government of India.
- 7. The amount sanctioned in para 6(ii) above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:

"4211-00 capital outlay on Family Welfare – 103 – Maternity and Child Health State's Expenditure – AA "Following under National Health Scheme – 16 Major Works".
