**ORDER:**

The Director of Medical Education has stated that based on the request of Director and Superintendent, Institute of Non-Communicable Diseases, Government Royapettah Hospital, Chennai the plan and estimate for construction of Radiation Oncology Block in Government Royapettah Hospital, Chennai has been prepared and based on the plan evolved by the Chief Architect the total plinth area of the building fixed as 206.00 sq.m in Ground Floor. In order to comply with the safety norms due to radiation, the detailed plan has been submitted to AERB and got approved by the Radiation Safety Division of AERB, Mumbai and due to its uniqueness, the structure is proposed with heavy R.C.C wall and roof as per norms.

2. Now the Director of Medical Education has forwarded the rough cost estimate prepared by the Engineer - in -Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai region and the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department for the work of construction of Radiation Oncology Block in Government Royapettah Hospital, Chennai for an amount of Rs.2.01 crore for the year 2013-2014 and Rs.2.21 crore for the year 2014-2015 assuming an escalation of 10%, approved by the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai, duly countersigned by the Director of Medical Education, Chennai.

3. The Director of Medical Education has, therefore, requested the Government to accord Administrative and Financial sanction for a sum of Rs.2.01 crore for the year 2013 -2014 and Rs.2.21 crore for the year

2014-2015 by adding 10% for escalation of costs, for the construction of Radiation Oncology Block in Government Royapettah Hospital, Chennai.

4. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.2.21 crore (Rupees Two Crore and Twenty One Lakhs only) for the year 2014-2015 by adding 10% for escalation of costs, for the construction of Radiation Oncology Block in Government Royapettah Hospital, Chennai subject to future equipment needs being met by National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardio - Vascular Diseases and Stroke (NPCDCS).

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"4210-Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health - 01- Urban Health Services - 110 - Hospitals and Dispensaries (Including Pharmacy) - (Scheme in the Twelfth Five year Plan-II) II State Plan - JA Buildings - 16 Major Works"  
(DPC - 4210-01-110-JA-1602)".

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will initially be met by an advance from the contingency fund. Orders regarding the sanction of advance from the contingency fund will be issued by the Finance (BG-1) Department separately. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is directed to send an application in the prescribed format along with copy of this order to Finance (BG-1) Department for sanction of advance for the required quantum. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is also directed to send necessary note for inclusion of Expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate for the year 2014-2015 to Finance (Health-II/BG-1/BG-II) at the appropriate stage.
