ORDER:

In Government Order first read above, orders have been issued for revision of guidelines and syllabus for the training to be imparted for Multipurpose Health Worker (Male) / Health Inspector / Sanitary Inspector course offered by the Private Institution / Trust / Universities / Deemed Universities.

2. In the letter second read above, the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has stated that the Managing Trustee, Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) Institute, Dindigul has applied for permission to start two years Health Inspector course in the prescribed format. Further, he has stated scrutiny of the application of the said institution it was found that the said Institution has followed the guidelines to start the Health Inspector Course. The Joint Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine (Training) has inspected the above institution on 15.7.2017. The Director has, therefore, requested that permission may be accorded to the Managing Trustee, Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) Institute, Dindigul, who had applied for permission to start two years Health Inspector Course with an annual intake of 40 students per batch / per year and submitted that the said Institution has followed the guidelines to start the Health Inspector Course.

3. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has recommended the request of the Managing Trustee, Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) Institute, Dindigul to start Health Inspector Course with an annual intake of 40 students per batch / per year, subject to the following conditions:

- a) The Training Institute should be affiliated to a Community Health Centre and an Urban Local Body near to the institution in order to provide field practice and required orders shall be obtained from the competent local authority;
- b) The Teaching Facilities, Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff, Office, Classrooms, Laboratory, Sanitary Engineering Workshop, Library, Health Education Section should be as per the prescribed guidelines;

c) The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine will be the Chairman of the Board of Examination to conduct the examinations of Health Inspector course, subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The candidates will be informed in writing that successful candidates will not claim himself as eligible for Tamil Nadu Government Service as a matter of right;
- ii. The fees prescribed by the Government shall be remitted into Government Treasury for the allotted Community Health Centre / Urban Local Body for field practice training by the Institution;
- iii. The Institute and the candidates should pay the prescribed examination fees at the rate decided time to time by the Board of Examination;
- iv. The selection rules, curriculum and regulations given in the annexure of the Government Order first read above should be followed without fail and deviation.

4. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the recommendation of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine and hereby direct that the Managing Trustee, Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) Institute, Dindigul be permitted to start two years Health Inspector Course at S.F.No.693/1, 2, 694/2A, 2B, 2C at Kathiranampatti, Kothapulli Panchayat, Dindigul Taluk (West), Dindigul District with an annual intake of 40 students per batch from the academic year 2019-20, subject to the conditions mentioned at para 3 above and the Institution should submit the Building Plan approved by the Director of Town and Country Planning, before admitting the students for the above said course.

5. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine should ensure that the conditions prescribed at para 4 above are fulfilled by the Managing Trustee, Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) Institute, Dindigul.
