ORDER:

The Hon'ble Chief Minister under Rule 110 has announced on the floor of the assembly on 14.6.2018 that Strengthening of Maternal and Child Health Wings in Government Hospitals at Kumbakonam, Ramanathapuram, Virudhunagar, Kancheepuram, Tirupattur, Ooty and Jayamkondan at Rs.12.70 crore for civil works.

2. In order to provide State—of—the—art Maternal and Child Health (MCH) Care Services, Professional Education and Training and Mentoring Services to Primary Health Corress and other Government Hospitals, Covernment in strengthening Maternal and Child Health wings in strategic Government Medical College Hospitals and Government Hospitals. Thus, it is essential to strengthen the Maternal and Child Health Wings in the following Hospitals in the State during the year 2018-19 at the total cost as noted against each of them.

- 3. A detailed proposal has been included in Programme Implementation Plan 2018-19, for strengthening Maternal and Child Health Wing in the above hospitals with a total budgetary requirement of Rs.12700 lakh for 7 institutions. The proposal is approved in Record of Proceedings by the Government of India at a total cost of Rs.12,700 lakh for both Civil Works and equipment, with budgetary provision of funds Rs.1,270 lakh, for the year 2018-19, i.e at 10% of the total requirement of Rs.12,700 lakh approved. The balance of funds required in this regard has to be proposed in the subsequent Programme Implementation Plans.
- 4. The above proposal has been approved by the Executive Committee in the 35th Executive Committee Meeting held on 16.05.2018. Vide Agenda No.8.
- 5. The funds Rs. 1270 lakhs approved for the year 2018-19, for strengthening Maternal and Child Health wings in 7 Government Hospitals as detailed above has been remitted into Government Account as per the directions issued in G.O(Ms) No.116, Health and Family Welfare (EAP II -2) Department, dated 25.03.2011, for the execution of works through Public Works Department.
- 6. The Mission Director, National Health Mission has requested necessary orders in this regard.
- 7. The Government after careful consideration decided to accept the proposal of the Mission Director, National Health Mission and accordingly order as follows:
 - i. Administrative sanction is accorded to strengthen Maternal and Child Health wings in 7 Government Hospitais as detailed below at a cost mentioned against each of them for both civil works and equipment/furniture.

ii. Sanction is accorded for sum of Rs.12.70 crore (Rupees Twelve crore and seventy lakh only) for executing the above civil works through Public Works Department at 10% of the total requirement of Rs.12700 lakh approved.

- iii. The Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai is permitted to issue orders to the Executive Engineers of the concerned divisions for the drawal of funds.
- iv. The Mission Director, State Health Society Tamil Nadu, Chennai is permitted to remit the balance of funds required for strengthening Maternal and Child Health wings in 7 Government Hospitals as and when the funds are approved by Government of India.
- 8. The amount sanctioned in para 7 (ii) above shall be debited to the following Head of Account

"4211-00 capital outlay on Family Welfare-103 Maternity and Child Health-State's Expenditure – AA civil works under National Health Mission Scheme – 16 major works".
