ORDER:

The Government of Tamil Nadu with an aim to promote the people's welfare is being implementing the free medical services through Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme.

- 2. The World Health Organization has declared the existing COVID-19 effect as global public health hazard and as a controllable phenomenon. On this basis, the Government of Tamil Nadu under Public Health Scheme has issued an announcement in the Government Gazette declaring COVID-19 pandemic across Tamil Nadu as Scheduled disease. Also, with an objective to prevent this Covid-19 infection, guideline procedures have been issued according to Epidemic Act 1897. Further, according to Revenue and Disaster Management Act 2005, precaution and preventive guidelines for Covid-19 infection have been issued.
- 3. In the Government Order fifth read above, in order to protect public health and to provide free treatment, cost for Covid-19 treatment has been increased. It was also informed that the increased fee would be reconsidered within two months depending on the nature of the infection.

- 4. In the letter sixth read above, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has stated that in the high level special committee meeting held on 12.07.2021, as mentioned in the Government Order fifth read above, revising the increased fee for Covid-19 treatment in the Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme depending on the nature of the infection after two months was reconsidered and also submitted a proposal to the Government as per the decisions of the High level special committee meeting.
- 5. After careful consideration of the proposal of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project, the Government of Tamil Nadu have ordered as follows:
 - a) Considering the decrease in the level of Covid infection, under Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme, per day cost of Covid-19 infection has been revised as package cost as below:-
